1. When is the Doctor of Medicine Application Period?

2. What is the Doctor of Medicine Application Process?

- You can apply for Doctor of Medicine by filling out the Online Application Form and follow the instructions given at myDLSMHSI portal

https://myhsi.dlshsi.edu.ph:8443/PARENTS_STUDENTS/parents_student_index.jsp.

Afterwards, you can pay the Admissions Processing Fee of Php 2,000.00 (for Filipino applicants) or \$250.00 (for foreign applicants) then submit the document requirements and information together with the proof of payment (validated deposit slip or Official Receipt) to Center for Lasallian Admission, Scholarship, and Testing (CLAST) via email at admissionscm@dlsmhsi.edu.ph.

3. What are the requirements for enrollment for Doctor of Medicine?

- Here are the General Requirements for the Doctor of Medicine:

1. NMAT Results
2. Transcript of Records (TOR) / Certification of Grades
3. PSA Birth Certificate
4. Certificate of General Weighted Average (GWA) / Certificate of General Pointed Average (GPA)
5. Two (2) sets of completed and signed Certification of Recommendation from previous professor / previous employer (if the applicant is working already).
6. Notarized Sworn Statement
7. Certificate of Graduation / Diploma or Certificate of Candidacy for Graduation
8. Police or NBI Clearance
9. Completed Google Form

4. What if my enrollment requirements are incomplete?
- If you currently have incomplete requirements, you may still proceed with your application. For applicants who cannot submit the original documents on or before enrollment, you can submit the Original Notarized Provisional Enrollment Form for you to enroll temporarily.

5. What is the Doctor of Medicine interview schedule and process?
- After receiving your confirmation email from CLAST, log in to the applicant's portal and choose your preferred interview schedule. Please read the written guidelines and other important details provided in preparation for your interview. A rescheduling fee of Php 500.00 shall be paid if the applicant fails to attend or wishes to reschedule their interview. Kindly check the applicant's portal at least one (1) week after your interview or contact CLAST for the final result of the evaluation.

- After receiving your confirmation email from CLAST, log in to the applicant's portal and choose your preferred interview schedule. Please read the written guidelines and other important details provided in preparation for your interview.
