

SCHOOL OF ADVANCED STUDIES - SCHOLARSHIP

1. Is there a scholarship for Graduate Studies?
 - The Graduate Education Scholarship Opportunities (GESO) are awarded to postgraduate students who excel academically and/or have financial difficulties and are interested in providing support services to the Graduate Studies in Medical and Health Sciences (GSMHS).

2. What is the Scholarship procedure?
 - Below are the steps for Scholarship procedure:
 1. Fill out the Scholarship Application Form for PostGrad Scholarship and rename the file as: Last Name, First Name, Middle Name and Temporary/Student ID number. Save in PDF format.
 2. Upload the following Requirements:
 - COE and Reference Letter
 - TOR (Undergraduate for Masters; Masters for PhD)
 - Membership identification card or certificate and/or proof of community service
 - Evidence of research and publication engagements (e.g. certification, technical report, article)
 - Certificate of Employment (with indicated income) or BIR Form 2316 (Certificate of Compensation Payment or Income Tax Withheld) or 1 month pay slip. If married, both the student and their spouse need to submit income evidence. If single, only the applicant's relevant document is needed.
 - Registration Form for last semester enrollment (for renewal).
 3. The student-applicant who will be considered pre-qualified based on the submitted documents, will be scheduled for an interview.
 4. Screening/deliberation for the number of applicants to be awarded with scholarship shall be contingent on the available budget and meeting the required points.
