SCHOOL OF ADVANCED STUDIES - ADMISSION

1. When is the Graduate Studies application period and procedure?

- The application for Academic Year 2026–2027 is now open.

You can apply by filling out the Online Application Form and follow the instructions given at myDLSMHSI portal

Afterwards, you can pay the Admissions Processing Fee of Php 2,000.00 (for Filipino applicants) or \$250.00 (for foreign applicants), then submit the following requirements and information together with the proof of payment (validated deposit slip) to Center for Lasallian Admission, Scholarship, and Testing (CLAST) through email at postgradadmission@dlsmhsi.edu.ph

2. What is the Graduate Studies interview schedule and process?

- After receiving your confirmation email from CLAST, log in to the applicant's portal at

https://myhsi.dlshsi.edu.ph:8443/PARENTS_STUDENTS/parents_student_index.jsp and choose your preferred interview schedule. A rescheduling fee of Php

500.00 shall be paid if the applicant fails to attend or wishes to reschedule their interview schedule.

 - Photocopy of Philippine Nursing Association (PNA) ID, PRC License, and (1) certificate of membership in any recognized nursing organization
 - Curriculum Vitae

 - Completed and Signed Preliminary Information for Application
 - Completed **Capsule Proposal** for Dissertation 1 & 2

6. What are the enrollment requirements for Master of Science in Radiologic Technology?

- Below are the list of enrollment requirements for Master in Public Health?
 - Transcript of Records (TOR)
 - Photocopy of PRC License and Valid ID
 - Updated Curriculum Vitae and Resume
 - Two (2) Recommendation Letters from professional or academic sources (address the letter to: Dr. Alvin D. Crudo, Dean, School of Advanced Studies)
 - Certificate of Good Moral Character from the last school attended and/or current employer.
 - Two (2) copies of 2x2 ID Photos with white background
 - Proof of Payment of Application Fee

SCHOOL OF ADVANCED STUDIES - SCHOLARSHIP

1. Is there a scholarship for Graduate Studies?
 - The Graduate Education Scholarship Opportunities (GESO) are awarded to postgraduate students who excel academically and/or have financial difficulties and are interested in providing support services to the Graduate Studies in Medical and Health Sciences (GSMHS).

2. What is the Scholarship procedure?
 - Below are the steps for Scholarship procedure:
 1. Fill out the Scholarship Application Form for PostGrad Scholarship and rename the file as: Last Name, First Name, Middle Name and Temporary/Student ID number. Save in PDF format.
 2. Upload the following Requirements:
 - COE and Reference Letter
 - TOR (Undergraduate for Masters; Masters for PhD)
 - Membership identification card or certificate and/or proof of community service
 - Evidence of research and publication engagements (e.g. certification, technical report, article)
 - Certificate of Employment (with indicated income) or BIR Form 2316 (Certificate of Compensation Payment or Income Tax Withheld) or 1 month pay slip. If married, both the student and their spouse need to submit income evidence. If single, only the applicant's relevant document is needed.
 - Registration Form for last semester enrollment (for renewal).
 3. The student-applicant who will be considered pre-qualified based on the submitted documents, will be scheduled for an interview.
 4. Screening/deliberation for the number of applicants to be awarded with scholarship shall be contingent on the available budget and meeting the required points.
