Booking 3G Pitches - guidance

- 1. The Venue cannot have netting wires across the pitch and must reach the FA minimum size of 100 x 60 metres
- 2. There must be 3 separate changing rooms for the 2 sides and match official-minimum size 12 metres squared and 4 metres squared for the match official with separate showers. These must be lockable.
- 3. Any potential booking which sees a change of kick off time MUST BE AGREED IN ADVANCE with the opposition before being booked.
- 4. The away team cannot expect to travel well outside the distance already travelling and in a completely different direction. For example, a side from Portsmouth travelling to a side in Southampton, should not be expected to then have to travel to Aldershot/Basingstoke.

Round-Up

Three **midweek** games scheduled this week, all in the **Russell Cotes Cup**. On Tuesday, Colden Common did really well at Wessex Prem Hamble Club, and only lost by the odd goal in five, the winner coming in injury time. The Stallions had led until the 84th minute. On Wednesday, both games were postponed after heavy rain during the day.

More rain until **the weekend** saw a few games postponed on Saturday, but we got quite a few games, and there was plenty of excitement.

In the **Senior Division**, we have new leaders, as Infinity knocked Locks Heath off the top with a big 6-4 victory at the Lumacon, with an Osman hat-trick for the hosts, who also conceded two own goals. Liphook also climbed above Locks and are now second after a close 2-1 home win over in-form Colden Common. Ian Steele reported:

'On a disgusting day (weatherwise) Liphook and Common served up a feast of football which provided end-to-end action, chances, mistakes and a thumping winner (Sir Bobby Charlton-like) for the victors'._

Denmead missed their chance to move into third as they lost 2-3 at home to Sway.

All four games were played in **Division 1**, where the top two met at the NormRod, and it was Hedge End Town who beat leaders Meon Milton 4-1 to replace them at the summit. Longland got two goals for HET. Third v fourth turned out to be fairly one-sided as Hedge End Rangers got off to a great start and eventually beat Headley United 5-0 at the Deer Park. Whiteley Wanderers, helped by a brace from Farlow, go into fourth after an excellent 3-2 at QK Southampton, and Upham continue their resurgence, moving into fifth after a 6-1 home win over Lyndhurst, Bode and sub Maurin got two each.

Senior Division Bishops Waltham Dynamos progressed to the next round of the **Southampton Senior Cup** but were taken all the way, beating lowly Division 1 Michelmersh & Timsbury on penalties after a 1-1 draw.

We had one game in the **George Mason Memorial Shield**, with Twentyten, bottom of Division 1, recording an exceptional 4-2 home win over Senior Division Moneyfields Res.

In the **North Hants Senior Cup,** Overton United recorded their second cup win in consecutives weeks with a 2-0 win at Broughton, Short and Tennant the scorers.
