Round-Up

We had a few midweek games scheduled this week, one even taking advantage of British Summer Time and playing early evening under daylight.

On **Monday** Harvest and Denmead played out a 2-2 draw at Front Lawn, the home ground for both teams. The result didn't really help either team as both stay in the bottom four of the Senior Division, a point better off than Moneyfields Res. Vickers and Steere were on target for Harvest, Hopwood got both for the Mead.

Tuesday saw another Senior Division game, with Liphook United recording a good win in one of their games in hand, 3-0 at Bishops Waltham Dynamos. Bray, H.Smith, and Theuma were their scorers.

On **Wednesday** we had matches in both Divisions.

The **Senior Division** saw leaders Infinity play their last game of the season, a 2-2 draw with Whitehill & Bordon, Osman getting both home goals. They must now wait and see whether the three chasing teams, all with games in hand, can overtake them. They reported an excellent attendance of 163.

Division 1 featured El Hedgio, the Hedge End derby, which saw Hedge End Rangers record a 3-1 win in front of a big crowd at the NormRod against HET, who are now winless in four, and, despite their games in hand, would now not be able to overtake their rivals if Rangers win their final game. Nicholls, Massey and Bickley were on target for the visitors. There was a remarkable score at Winklebury, where third-bottom Twentyten, who had been four games unbeaten, scoring 17 goals, were beaten 3-8 by Headley United, SEVEN of these coming from Benstead, according to Full-Time.

The **weekend** saw only one postponement, and a couple of reversals.

In the **Senior Division**, leaders Infinity have now finished their programme, so the chasing teams all had a chance to make inroads on their lead. Two out of three did. Locks Heath, in second, had a solid 2-0 win at bottom club Fleet Spurs, the goals from Dugan and C.Smith (pen). Fourth-placed Stockbridge won 4-1 at Sway (two of those from Graham) to keep their promotion hopes alive. But third-placed Liphook United lost 2-3 at Liss Athletic in an exciting A3 derby before an estimated 190 spectators, although Liphook still have eight games still to play and are nine points behind Infinity. Liss moved into fifth as a result of this win and are now six unbeaten in the league. Harrison got two of their goals, Butler the other one. Sellitto and Allcock were on target for Liphook. At the other end of the table, there was a vital win for Hayling United after five defeats in a row - 2-1 over Hook, a team in form. The win was achieved thanks two goals from Southon, despite the Bugs being a goal down at the break and having to reverse the fixture due to an unfit pitch at Hayling College. Two teams near the bottom who managed long overdue wins were Denmead, with a good 6-2 home win over Whitehill & Bordon, their first league win

in eight, and Harvest, who added to Bishops Waltham Dynamos' woes with a 3-0 win at the Mountbatten, their first win in six. Colden Common beat Paulsgrove 6-2 at Oakwood Park to draw level with them in mid-table, and the Stallions even have a game in hand. The Grove took a two-goal lead, but a big comeback, aided by an Ali hat-trick, gave Common the points.

In **Division 1**, the leaders, Hedge End Rangers, have only one game left after their derby victory in the week, and it wasn't this weekend. Of the chasing teams, only Hedge End Town ended up playing, and they had a good 2-0 home win over AFC Netley. However, only Meon Milton can currently overtake Rangers if they win their games in hand. Headley United followed up their 8-3 victory at Twentyten in midweek with a 3-0 win over Overton to move into fifth, while Twentyten bounced back from that defeat with a big 6-1 win over Michelmersh & Timsbury (who will now finish bottom, barring a 30-goal swing), in a game switched to Timsbury. Finally, QK Southampton broke a run of six successive defeats with a 4-4 draw at home to third-bottom Broughton. Allen got two for the visitors.
