Clubs **MUST** contact the League about their postponements before posting publicly on social media.

The League is unable to agree to postpone any fixture on unsubstantiated claims relating to player availability. Clubs failing to fulfil fixtures for any reason will be charged.

### Important reminders

The home club should pay the referee's fee before or immediately after the game, not later than 8pm on the day of the match.

All clubs need to update players' suspensions following matches to ensure they do not remain showing as suspended.

Contact from clubs to the League must be made by the Club Secretary to the League Secretary.

## **A polite reminder...**

...of various issues which have been brought to our attention which must be adhered to.

### **Pitch Surrounds**

All pitches must have a barrier or a minimum of a stake and rope around all sides accessed by spectators. FA respect barriers are also suitable.

### **Spectators at 3G venues**

Should not be permitted to stand pitchside except on the side(s) where there is hard standing for spectators to stand.

### **Technical Areas**

\*Must be marked out or in the case of venues where they cannot be marked out (3G pitches for example) cones or discs you use for players warm ups to show the technical areas can be used.

### **Dug Outs**

Are a requirement in the Senior Division. Seating a minimum of 8.

### **Small Sided Goals**

Please ensure that any goals pitchside are moved well away from the pitch. In the case of 3G venues back into the enclaves built into the side of the pitch.

## **A note about jewellery**

Clubs are asked to remind players that ALL jewellery, including ear studs, must be removed before entering the field of play.

Simply taping over the jewellery is not permitted and the referee will ask the player to leave the field of play and remove it thus becoming a player short until such time it has been removed.

## Round-Up

And yet again.... we had lot of rain in midweek.

It was still very wet, we had five postponements, but we still got ten games played this week, all league encounters. Six of those were played on 3/4G.

In the **Senior Division**, leaders Locks Heath's game was off, so it was a chance for the teams behind them, three teams locked together on 35 points four points behind Locks, to try and make some ground up, and this they did, all recording victories.

Crofton Saints, continue in second after a good 3-0 win at Southsea Sports, two of them from Clark. Hook had a 5-1 home win over unpredictable Denmead. Hedge End Rangers, still yet to lose in the league at Sholing, had a 2-0 home win over Broughton to end the visitors' run of five unbeaten. Meon Milton drew 2-2 with Bishops Waltham Dynamos at the Cockleshell after losing to them away last weekend. Easen and Maloney for Meon, Street and C.Steele for the visitors, who finished with ten men.

In **Division One**, the top two had games against teams in the bottom three, and both won by a single goal. Overton United beat Mob Albion 1-0, thanks to a goal from Martin, his team having put six past them last week, so a clear improvement from the visitors. AFC Netley won 2-1 at Twentyten in a close game, both goals from Blaxall. Tyson was on target for Twentyten. Behind them, only Silchester Village of the top five were in action, and they lost 2-3 at Hayling United (Metherell with the winner), whose second win in a row this was after a poor run. Whiteley Wanderers are now level with Silchester after a 1-0 win at bottom club Paulsgrove, Chambers with the winner. Headley United move further clear of the bottom three (with games in hand) after a good 4-1 win over Nursling & Shirley, a big blow to N&S's top five hopes. Rushmoor Community and Sway drew 2-2, which helped both teams keep clear of the bottom places.

## **Match Report**

### **Paulsgrove 0 Whiteley Wanderers 1 at King George V Cosham**

A trip down the A27 to watch Paulsgrove, one of the few teams I have not watched yet either home or away this season.

After 10 minutes, a couple of half chances fell to Whiteley, both shots going wide.

Whiteley continued to press, and after 20 minutes a shot from Lintott from all of 40 yards sailed over the bar. On 25 minutes there was a series of Whiteley corners from the right-hand side, scrambled away, one even hitting the post. Another shot from Whiteley's

Tisdale after 41 minutes from 20 yards was just over the bar. A totally dominant first half by Whiteley with nothing to show, Paulsgrove hardly got into the opposition half.

A little brighter start from Paulsgrove early in the second half, but Whiteley continued to pile on the pressure. On 50 minutes a shot from Moore of Whiteley from the edge of the 18, just wide. Finally, in the heavy rain Chambers of Whiteley managed to get a shot on target from the corner of the box to make it 0-1. Chambers is due to play at Twickenham next week for the Army, so a good week for him [with thanks to Paul C].
