# A polite reminder...

...of various issues which have been brought to our attention which must be adhered to.

#### **Pitch Surrounds**

All pitches must have a barrier or a minimum of a stake and rope around all sides accessed by spectators. FA respect barriers are also suitable.

## **Spectators at 3G venues**

Should not be permitted to stand pitchside except on the side(s) where there is hard standing for spectators to stand.

#### **Technical Areas**

Must be marked out or in the case of venues where they cannot be marked out (3G pitches for example) cones or discs you use for players warm ups to show the technical areas can be used,

#### **Dug Outs**

Are a requirement in the Senior Division. Seating a minimum of 8.

#### **Small Sided Goals**

Please ensure that any goals pitchside are moved well away from the pitch. In the case of 3G venues back into the enclaves built into the side of the pitch.

#### **BE PART OF PLAY SAFE 2024**

# **Round-Up**

We had a couple of fixtures on **Tuesday**: in the Senior Division, Bishops Waltham Dynamos recorded their second win of the season with a 2-0 home win over Stockbridge - a goal in each half by Riddell and Gray for the hosts - and Liss Athletic lost at Moneyfields, now in the Isthmian League, in the Portsmouth Senior Cup.

**Saturday** saw the first round of the uhlsport Hampshire Premier League Cup, involving all our teams.

The losing teams go into the George Mason Memorial Shield.

Frankly, this was a ridiculous day, with 80 goals in 14 games and five penalty shootouts! And, of course, we had our fair share of upsets.

Both last year's winners and last year's finalists are out.

There were several ties where Div 1 teams played Senior Division teams, with Senior Division teams having home advantage in most cases.

There were three exceptions, and all three games proved to be thrillers: **Hedge End Town** beat Paulsgrove, bottom of the Senior Division, on penalties after a 2-2 draw; **Mob Albion**, on a decent run of form, beat Denmead 6-3, with Kaberry and sub Sills both twice on target for Mob; AFC Netley lost 2-3 to **Hook**, for whom Colson got a hat-trick after Netley had come back twice.

Amongst the Div 1 teams travelling to Senior Division opposition there was a fascinating tie with **Broughton**, flying high at the top of their league with five wins out of five, going to Andover Town, who were in Wessex 1 last season, and who are improving after a slow start to life in the HPFL. This proved to be a tight affair and went to penalties after a goalless 90 minutes, Broughton finally coming out on top.

**Silchester** have had a decent start to life in Div 1 and travelled to Bishops Waltham Town. They managed an exciting 4-4 draw and also won the penalty shootout, thereby putting out the Cup holders. Tennant got a hat-trick for Silchester.

Neither Sway nor **Twentyten** have enjoyed the best of starts to the season and they met at Jubilee Field, the visitors producing a shock 5-2 win, with two late goals from Worsfold.

Four Div 1 teams faced tough journeys to teams in the top 5 of of the Senior Division: Hayling United lost 1-5 at **Colden Common** (two more goals for Bath), Headley United lost 2-3 at **Hedge End Rangers** (Rangers' sixth win in a row – Gould, McIndoe and Hurst their scorers), and Rushmoor Community lost 1-4 at **Meon Milton**, but Overton United took Senior Division leaders **Liphook United** to penalties, losing in the shootout. Smith and Theuma scored in normal time for Liphook, Sentch and Wilson for Overton.

There were some close-looking ties between teams in the Senior Division, and so it proved: Liss Athletic lost 3-4 at home to **Harvest**, despite a Butler hat-trick — this was Harvest's third win over Liss this season. Stockbridge were beaten 1-4 at home by **Moneyfields Res**, for whom Cooper scored twice, and last year's finalists Locks Heath shared 10 goals with **Whitehill & Bordon** but lost on penalties. Joe Davis got two for Locks, Coyne got two for the Stags.

The remaining match between Division 1 sides saw the Whiteley Wanderers v **Upham** match produce a remarkable 3-9 scoreline. A hat-trick from Maurin and doubles from Mesa and sub Bode formed a big part of the visitors' win.
