

GIVING AT YEAR END

DAFs: If you have established a Donor Advised Fund, you can request the fund administrator to direct a contribution to Christ Church or to the Christ Church Foundation before the end of the year. Take advantage of this popular contribution vehicle!

IRAs: Are you 70½ or older and have an IRA? If you answer yes, then you may give up to \$100,000 directly from your IRA as a qualified charitable distribution (QCD). The QCD counts toward satisfying the required minimum distribution – and – excludes the distribution from the taxpayer's income.
