Our upcoming schedule for continuing these conversations is as follows. Please mark your calendars:

Sunday, January 27, 11:30 a.m. (Auditorium) and 4:00 p.m. (Meade Room)

Our rescheduled exploratory conversations with time for question and answer about the option we are exploring, and about the non-binding letter of intent that is currently being negotiated. These conversations will help us in determining those things our parish community is concerned about and make sure that we are taking those into account as we continue to explore a development option.

Sunday, February 3, 11:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., and Sunday, February 10, 11:30 a.m., (Auditorium)

The committee will explain the terms of the Letter of Intent (LOI) and we will have the opportunity to discuss it in small groups and to better understand it. We will be holding a special session for our 8:00 a.m. church attendees in the Library following that service on February 3.

Sunday February 24, 10:15 a.m.

Based on what we have understood of the LOI, we will be voting at our annual parish meeting to enter a ground lease with development partners. If we vote to enter the ground lease, we will then go to the diocese in order to gain consent to move forward with the lease.

Thus far, the response to the possibilities that the committee has put forth has been largely positive. Several thoughtful concerns have been addressed and we are looking forward to hearing more questions, celebrations, concerns and hopes from the parish. Blessings,
