#### **47th Annual MLK Awards Banquet** (January 17, 2026)

The annual Martin Luther King Jr. Awards Banquet is an Athens' tradition that allows the AAHRC the opportunity to present scholarships to deserving high-school seniors and to recognize the dedication of community volunteers. The banquet emphasizes the goal of creating the Beloved Community.
