

GENERAL SECTION

I. GENERAL INFORMATION: DISCLOSURES

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

The list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, grave opening, flowers, and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on our bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Certain funeral services may be provided off-premises by other funeral service providers.

II. PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

A. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff	\$2,650.00

This fee for our services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.) Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff available 24 hours daily to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during, and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, and others. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as professional licensing, accounting fees, insurance, utility expenses, building maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping and secretarial and administrative expenses.

III. FUNERAL HOME FACILITIES

A. Facilities and Staff for Funeral Ceremony: (Chapel or Church)	\$ 500.00
B. Facilities and Staff for Visitation and Viewing (After 3 pm or more than 1 hour)	\$ 450.00
C. Facilities and Staff for Memorial Service	\$ 375.00
D. Equipment and Staff for Graveside Service	\$ 450.00

Our charges for facilities and staff includes coordination and direction of funeral services and participants; necessary personnel to supervise and coordinate church or memorial services; preparation, supervision, and attendants for visitation periods; arrangement of floral pieces and other memorial tributes; supervision and attendant at the graveside.

IV. EMBALMING

A. Autopsy Remains	\$ 1000.00
B. Normal Remains	\$ 900.00

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements,

such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

A mileage charge of \$2.25 per loaded mile will be charged for us to travel outside a 35 mile radius of Lovingston.

Includes basic service, visitation, funeral ceremony, embalming, preparation of body, transfer of remains, hearse, flower van, and lead/service vehicle. (It does not include the use of a family car.)

*In most areas of the country, state and local laws do not require you to buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or a burial vault will satisfy these requirements.

IX. IMMEDIATE BURIAL

\$3,375.00 to \$14,975.00

Our charges for an immediate burial without a ceremony or viewing, includes our basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home within 35 mile radius of Livingston, alternative care of remains and a hearse to the cemetery.

X. DIRECT CREMATION

\$3,075.00 to \$9,375.00

Our charges for direct cremation without a funeral or visitation include our basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home, alternative care of remains and a base model urn. Transfer of remains to the crematory, crematory fee, and medical examiner's fee are additional.

State and local laws do not require a casket for direct cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are leak-proof cardboard container with wood base. There are some crematories that require the use of an alternative container.

XI. FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

Our charges for forwarding remains include our basic services for funeral home and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home, and embalming. This does not include merchandise, use of facilities for viewing and/or funeral service, or transportation.

XII. RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

\$2,650.00

Our charges for receiving remains include our basic service charge for funeral home and staff, and transportation to cemetery. This does not include use of facilities for visitation/viewing or funeral service or motor equipment.

XIII. CASH ADVANCE

Death certificates, opening and closing of grave, grave equipment, additional vault charges for weekends and holidays, newspapers, clergy honorarium, beautician, flowers, musician, medical examiner fee, and any other items you may ask us to purchase.
