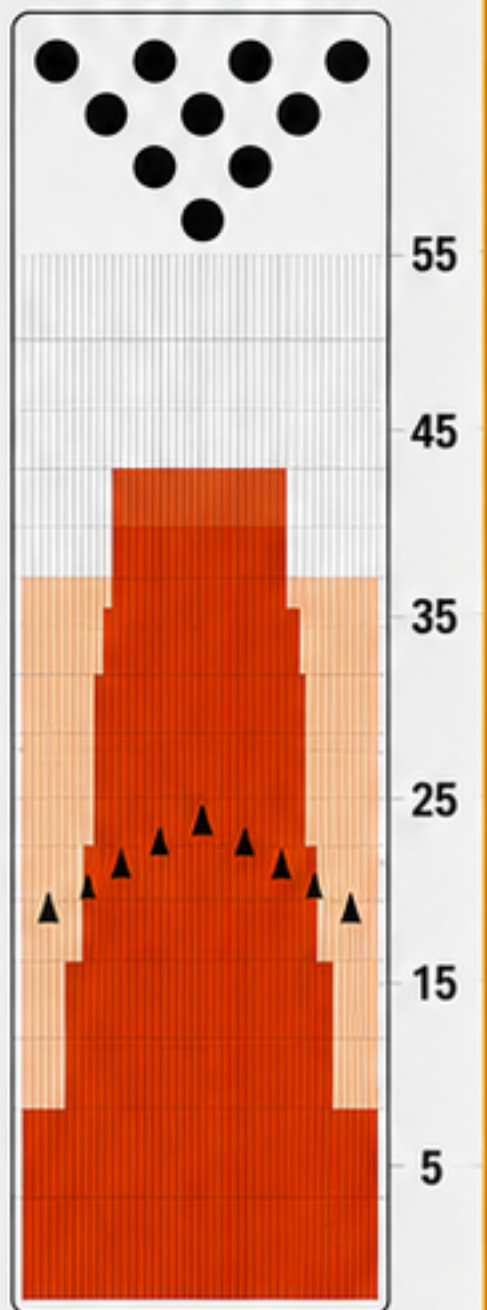

2026 EL PASO USBC SCRATCH CLASSIC TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY — This tournament is USBC certified and open to all USBC Certified Members. This is a scratch tournament and no handicap will be awarded. Two-lane courtesy will be observed throughout the tournament.

2. YOUTH PARTICIPATION — USBC Youth Members may compete under USBC Rule 400. Parental or guardian consent must be received at the time of entry. Any prize money earned by a youth bowler will be awarded as scholarship money through SMART. Youth bowlers assume responsibility for any effect participation may have on interscholastic or collegiate eligibility.

3. ENTRY FEE — First entry is \$85. Re-entry is \$65. Lineage is \$19.25 per entry and tournament expense/TD fee is \$1 per entry, with the remainder going to the prize fund. Make checks payable to El Paso USBC. A \$35 service charge applies to returned checks. El Paso USBC local dues are waived.

4. PRIZE FUND — The qualifying prize fund will be distributed among the eight bowlers advancing to the finals. Finals payout percentages are: 1st 40%; 2nd 20%; 3rd–4th 10% each; and 5th–8th 5% each. Payouts will be rounded to whole dollars, with any rounding remainder added to first place.

5. SCHEDULE & ENTRY DEADLINE — Qualifying squads are October 31, November 1 and November 7, 2026, at 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM. Entries close at the beginning of the final qualifying squad on November 7 at 2:00 PM. Finals will be held November 8, 2026. Entries are processed in the order received. Bowlers must check in before their scheduled squad and will receive their lane assignment and payment status at check-in.

6. QUALIFYING — Qualifying consists of five games. Competition lanes are 39–48, with a maximum squad capacity of 40 bowlers. Each bowler will bowl one game on each assigned pair according to the movement schedule printed on the recap sheet. Ten minutes of practice will be provided at the start of each squad and may be taken on any competition lane. A bowler may qualify for only one finals position; on re-entry, only the bowler's highest qualifying total counts.

7. HIGH GAME POT — An optional High Game Pot will be offered for each qualifying squad at \$10 per bowler (\$2 per game). The highest game wins each game's pot. Ties split that game's pot equally.

8. ADVANCEMENT & SEEDING — The top eight five-game qualifying totals advance to match play. Ties affecting seeds 1–8 are broken by highest qualifying game, then second-highest qualifying game, continuing through the remaining qualifying games as needed.

9. TIE FOR 8TH — A tie for the final qualifying position is decided by a one-game roll-off before match play. If still tied, a 9th-and-10th-frame roll-off will determine the qualifier.

10. FINALS MATCH PLAY — Finals use an eight-bowler bracket. Each match is a two-game total-pinfall match, single elimination, with no carryover pins from qualifying. The two-game format ensures each bowler completes a 10th frame on each lane. Ten minutes of practice will be provided at the beginning of match play on the competitors' assigned pair. Before each later match, each competitor receives one practice ball on each lane.

11. MATCH PLAY TIES — A tied match is decided by a one-ball roll-off. The higher seed determines order and starting lane. The winner advances and the loser is eliminated.

12. FINALS REPLACEMENT — If a finalist withdraws and a replacement is needed, the highest available bowler in the qualifying standings will replace that bowler. The replacement assumes the withdrawing bowler's position, and any prize earned will be split equally between the withdrawing bowler and replacement.

13. DRESS CODE — Clothing must be in good repair and not offensive. Shirts must have quarter-length sleeves. Pants, jeans, capris, shorts, skirts/skorts and hats are permitted. Shorts and skirts/skorts must be longer than fingertip length when arms are at the bowler's sides.

14. GOVERNING RULES — Any rule not covered by these tournament rules will be governed by USBC Playing Rules. All protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director.
