

COMPREHENSIVE BREAST EVALUATION.

Performed by a Board Certified Radiologist who specializes in breast diseases, the test includes:

- A low dose (47 millirad/ view), high resolution Mammogram with a Thomson CGR Dedicated Mammography System.
- Exclusive use of Kodak films, screens and chemistry in our dedicated processor.
- A thorough breast exam is performed to clinically correlate with the mammographic findings.
- When indicated, a breast ultrasound is performed utilizing a dedicated sonographic breast imager. This characterizes the cystic, complex, or solid nature of a region of interest.
- Personalized instruction in breast self-examination, including educational brochures.
- Quarterly Radiologic Physicist's evaluation and calibration to assure that our patients are exposed to the lowest possible radiation dose.

DIAGNOSTIC ULTRASOUND.

Procedures include:

— Obstetrical and high risk pregnancy monitoring, pelvic (transabdominal and/or transvaginal), abdominal, renal and thryoid. We also perform follicular maturation studies, and work closely with infertility specialists.

HIGH-RISK PREGNANCY.


Up to one-third of all pregnant women may be considered high risk. Women in this category include those over 35 years of age; those with pre-existing medical disorders, i.e. diabetes, hypertension, obesity etc., or a previous history of problem pregnancy(ies). For such highrisk cases, close, continuous monitoring of both mother and fetus is essential to ensure a safe delivery.

FETAL ASSESSMENT.

Conducted by a Board Certified specialist with extensive experience in maternal fetal medicine, our comprehensive fetal assessment program consists of the following four tests:

Obstetrical Sonogram

 Evaluates fetal anatomy, position, weight, compatibility with standard growth curves, quantity of amniotic fluid and placental grading.

Fetal Biophysical Profile

— Evaluates fetal activity, including presence, type, and quality of fetal movements. In additio to fetal tone and breathing, an acoustic stimulation test is performed which assesses feta reflex response; similar tests are taken at birth, as part of the Apgar score.

Umbilical and Uterine Artery Doppler Flow Velocimetry

— This non-invasive monitoring technique evaluates blood flow to the fetus. Abnormalities in placental circulation, the baby's lifeline, are often the first signs of fetal distress. By detecting such distress, the physician can intervene to help ensure the delivery of a healthy baby.

Non-Stress Test

 Fetal heart rate and movements are periodically recorded to determine the reactivity of the fetus.

Our purpose is to support the referring physician so he can provide the mother and fetus with the safest possible pregnancy and delivery. Our thorough diagnostic approach provides the most comprehensive means to that end.

Great Neck Womens' Medical Care offers other related services including: Prenatal Diagnosis by Amniocentesis and ancillary Genetic Counseling (when indicated), Nutritional Counseling for pregnant women, and Childbirth Education classes. All are provided, as our other services, in a comfortable non-hospital setting.

With these multiple screening and diagnostic modalities under one roof, we provide thorough evaluation in one diagnostic session. Now referring physicians can avoid sending their patients on multiple trips to multiple labs.
