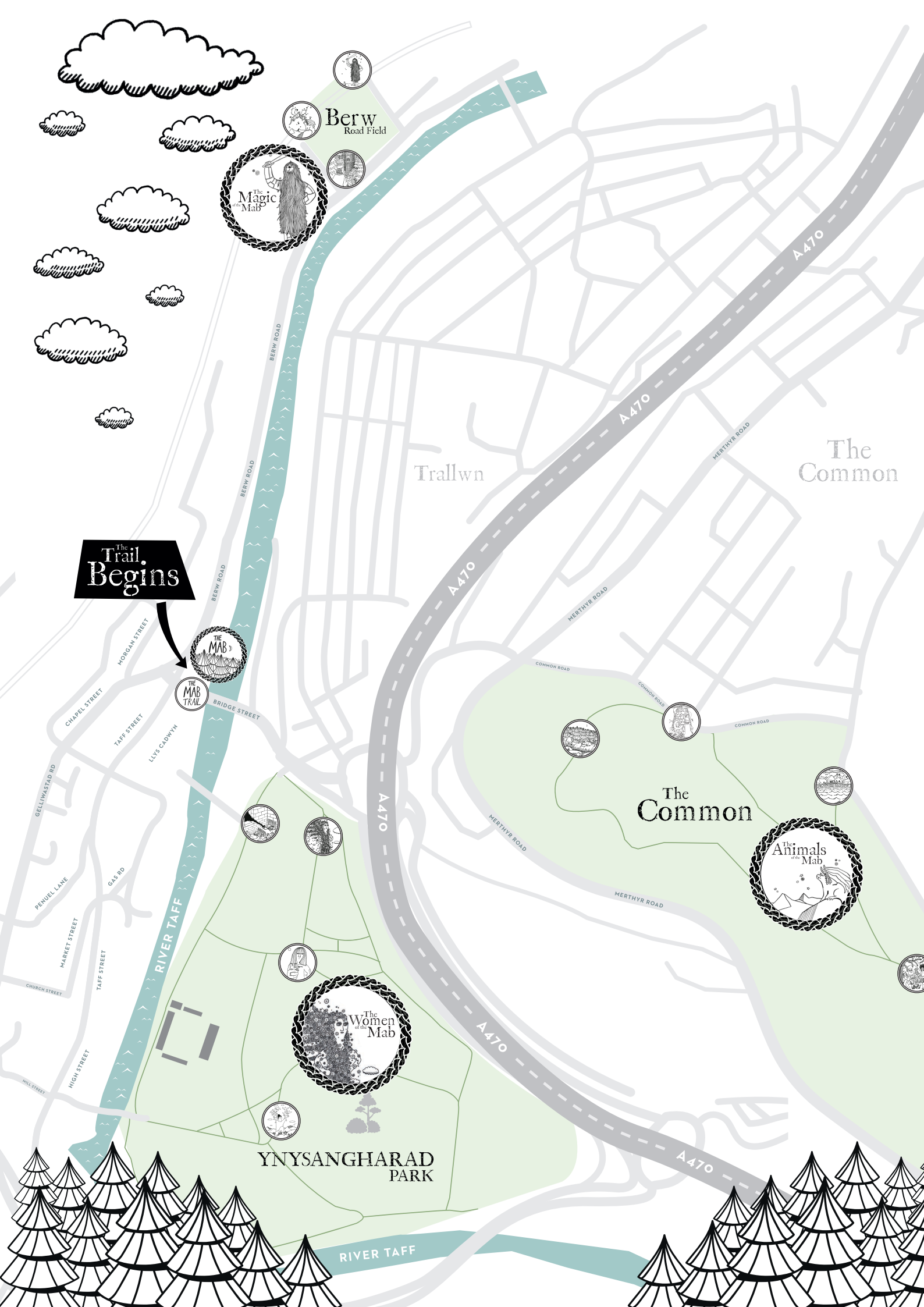

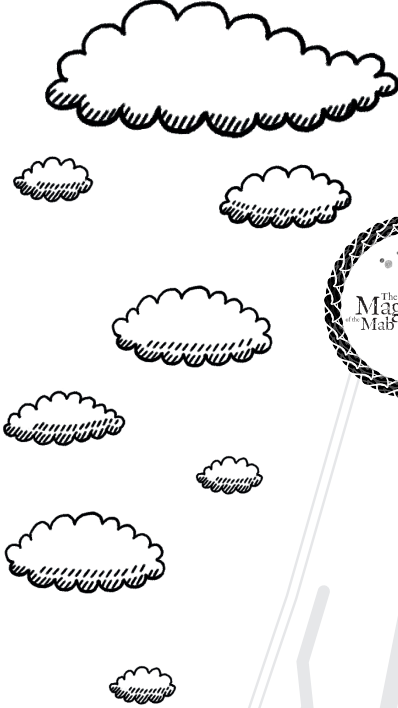
Notes:
