# **Vault Selection**

Vaults are available as needed, we work with local suppliers and will help facilitate the selection of a vault.

#### **Disbursements**

Items that are arranged for and paid for on your behalf by us are called disbursements. It is expected that you pay these items at the time the contract is entered into. Below are some examples of disbursements.

Coroner's fee - for issuing a certificate allowing cremation to take place, this fee is charged by the Coroner which is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Clergy Honorarium - This fee is determined either by clergy or you and is paid to the clergy for their services.

Newspaper or Radio Notices - To place death notices in newspapers or radio or other media networks, these charges apply.

Municipal Death Registration Fee - this fee is determined by the Municipality and may vary in order to register the death.

## **Payment Terms**

A 50% deposit will be required at the time the contract is signed, and the balance will be due within seven days following the day of delivery of supplies and services. Payment may be paid by cash, cheque, debit, and most major credit cards.

On any late payments, an interest rate of 1 1/2% per month, compounded monthly (equivalent to 19.56% per annum) until the date of full payment received will be charged. If the amount owing is not paid within 7 days from the date of delivery of supplies and services, any discount given will be null and void. It will be the purchaser's responsibility for any collection charges or fees that may be charged by a third-party collector. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged on all payments not honored by the financial institution.

#### **Pre- Arrangement Funding**

There are two funding options when prepaying services or supplies:

Insurance: A life insurance or annuity policy may be purchased. The proceeds of this policy will be used to pay these services or supplies. This will take place at the time these services or supplies are delivered or if the contract is cancelled.

Trust: Money received to us will be placed in a trust account. This money will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled.' (i.e., when the services and supplies are delivered) or cancelled.
