





DID YOU KNOW?

Who is a mandated reporter?

A mandated reporter is someone who is required to report suspected or disclosed cases of abuse to child protective services or law enforcement including a wide range of persons from teachers, educators, coaches, to school and parish staff, and clergy. The mandated report may involve concerns about possible abuse or neglect in the child's home or by a family member. At a school or parish, if the person making a report believes that child abuse or neglect is the case then the person should make the report to the local law enforcement agency, which has the resources and ability to intervene immediately if needed. The Archdiocese of Los Angeles urges all in our church to speak up to the appropriate authorities if any form of child abuse is suspected. ¿Quién es un informante obligatorio?

Los informantes obligatorios incluyen a maestros, educadores, entrenadores, y empleados de escuelas y miembros del clero. Un informe obligatorio puede incluir inquietudes sobre posibles abusos o negligencia en el hogar del niño o por parte de un miembro de la familia. En una escuela o parroquia, si la persona que realiza la denuncia cree que se trata de un caso de abuso o negligencia infantil, debe informar a la policía local que tiene los recursos y la capacidad para intervenir de forma inmediata si es necesario. La Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles urge a todos en nuestra iglesia a hablar con las autoridades correspondientes si se sospecha alguna forma de abuso infantil. Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time**Luke 18:9-14**

The Bible is filled with teachings about repentance which leads to a change of heart and lifestyle. When a person repents from all the bad things that they've done in their lives, it is then that they experience the peace and joy that God wills for us. We must remember that our God is not only loving and merciful, but He is also a just judge. We have a God that looks at every perspective in our lives. We cannot hope that He will give us the benefit of the doubt when we do bad. Our God is a merciful God and in order for there to be mercy, there must be justice. This is why it important for us to repent with a contrite heart so that we may receive God's mercy.

In today's Gospel reading, we see the heart of a tax collector being shredded by the guilt of his corruptness. His conscience does not allow him to have peace. The burden of his evil ways is so heavy that he cannot bear to look up to the heavens while in prayer. He has no poetic words to whisper to God or anything that he feels to be worthy enough to offer to God. However, he allows his heart to speak to the One that created Him with these humble words, "O God, be merciful to me a sinner." Jesus goes on to tell us that God justified the tax collector, meaning that God forgave him for his corrupt ways and gave him the grace needed to continue his life as a changed man according to God's will.

My brothers and sisters, there is no sin too big to be forgiven by God. Let's not focus just on God's judgement, but also consider His mercifulness. God does not will that we condemn ourselves to the fires of hell as a consequence of us choosing freely to live a life that is not according to God's will. God wills that we all be saved and be with Him for all eternity in heaven. For this to happen, we are required to go through the narrow gate and it all begins with our decision to humble ourselves like the tax collector and plead our case to God by repeating the same heartfelt words that he did by saying, "O God, be merciful to me a sinner."

Trigésimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**Lucas 18:9-14**

La Biblia está llena de enseñanzas sobre el arrepentimiento que conduce a un cambio de corazón y estilo de vida. Cuando una persona se arrepiente de todas las cosas malas que ha hecho en su vida, es entonces cuando experimenta la alegría y la paz que Dios desea para nosotros. Debemos recordar que nuestro Dios no solo es amoroso y misericordioso, sino también un juez justo. Tenemos un Dios que considera cada perspectiva de nuestras vidas. No podemos esperar que nos dé el beneficio de la duda cuando hacemos el mal. Nuestro Dios es un Dios misericordioso, y para que haya misericordia, debe haber justicia. Por eso es importante que nos arrepintamos con un corazón contrito para recibir la misericordia de Dios.

En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos el corazón de un publicano destrozado por la culpa de su corrupción. Su conciencia no le permite tener paz. La carga de sus malos caminos es tan pesada que no puede soportar mirar al cielo mientras ora. No tiene palabras poéticas para ofrecerle a Dios ni nada que considere digno como ofrenda. Sin embargo, permite que su corazón le hable a Aquel que lo creó con estas humildes palabras: «Dios mío, apiádate de mí, que soy un pecador». Jesús continúa diciéndonos que Dios justificó al publicano, es decir, que Dios lo perdonó por su corrupción y le dio la gracia necesaria para continuar su vida como un hombre transformado, conforme a la voluntad de Dios.

Hermanos y hermanas, no hay pecado demasiado grande que Dios no pueda perdonar. No nos centremos solo en el juicio de Dios, sino que consideremos también su misericordia. Dios no quiere que nos condenemos al fuego del infierno por elegir libremente vivir una vida que no se ajusta a Su voluntad. Dios quiere que todos seamos salvos y estemos con Él por toda la eternidad en el cielo. Para que esto suceda, debemos pasar por la puerta angosta y todo comienza con nuestra decisión de humillarnos como el publicano y presentar nuestro caso ante Dios repitiendo las mismas humildes palabras que él dijo al decir: «Dios mío, apiádate de mí, que soy un pecador».




