DID YOU KNOW?

Facts about physical grooming

The term "grooming" refers to the way in which a predator tries to mold and set up his victims and their families, in order to gain access to a child and cause harm, all while appearing innocent. The first of the three types of grooming is physical, and it involves touch. A predator starts with innocent touches — back pats, appropriate hugs — and then moves on to tickling, wrestling, hugging, conditioning the child to increasing levels of physical contact. Over time, the predator conditions the child to accept all forms of touch, progressing to sexual contact. Sobre los comportamientos de engaño

Los comportamientos de engaño (conocido en inglés como, grooming) se refiere a la forma en que un depredador intenta moldear y manipular a sus víctimas y a sus familias, con el fin de obtener acceso a un niño y causarle daño, todo ello mientras aparenta ser inocente. El primero de los tres tipos de comportamientos de engaño implica el contacto físico. Un depredador comienza con toques inocentes como palmaditas en la espalda, abrazos apropiados y luego pasa a las cosquillas, la lucha libre, los abrazos – acondicionando al niño a niveles cada vez mayores de contacto físico. Con el tiempo, el depredador condiciona al niño para que acepte todo tipo de contacto físico, avanzando hasta llegar al contacto sexual. The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls)

John 6:37-40

If someone were to ask you, "Who is Jesus?", what would your answer be? Would you shrug your shoulders and move on out of embarrassment or would you quickly respond that He is your Lord and Savior? If you find yourself in this situation and you just don't know how to answer it out of ignorance, then maybe it is time for you to get to know Jesus. Jesus is in fact our Lord and Savior. He is the Son of God and God at the same time. He is our friend and our master. He is also our healer and the most important healing that He performed was the healing of our relationship with the Father. This was healed by Him offering Himself on the cross for all of humanity. It is because of this act of love that one day we will have eternal life. The only thing missing is our will because we can easily reject Jesus as our Savior and therefore, rejecting eternal life.

As we remember our loved ones who have passed away, we have the hope that they did not reject Jesus' gift of salvation. We know that Jesus offers Himself for them and all of us with the hope that they will have eternal life. In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus makes a bold promise. He says that He will not reject anyone who is given to Him by the Father. He will not lose anyone that is given to Him and will raise them on the last day. He goes on to say that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life. This is where we come in, we must believe in Him and if we don't believe in Him, we will reject this gift of salvation.

My brothers and sisters, this All Souls Sunday, let's not only remember our loved ones with love and prayers, but let's also reflect on the state of our souls. Let's reflect on our relationship with Jesus Christ. Ask yourself this question, "Do I accept Him as your Lord and Savior?" When you see Him, especially in the Eucharist during communion, do you believe in Him? Do you believe in Him to the point that you follow all of His teachings and avoid sin? Believing is not just about words, but also actions. If you do this, next time that someone asks you who Jesus is, your heart and soul will jump at the opportunity to share your love and belief in Him and by doing so, you will inherit the reward of the promise of eternal life and being raised on the last day.

Commemoración de Todos los Fieles Difuntos

Juan 6:37-40

Si alguien te preguntara: "¿Quién es Jesús?", ¿qué responderías? ¿Dirías nada y seguirías adelante por vergüenza o responderías rápidamente que Él es tu Señor y Salvador? Si te encuentras en esta situación y simplemente no sabes qué responder por desconocimiento, entonces quizás sea el momento de conocer a Jesús. Jesús es, de hecho, nuestro Señor y Salvador. Es el Hijo de Dios y Dios mismo. Es nuestro amigo y nuestro maestro. También es nuestro sanador, y la sanación más importante que realizó fue la de nuestra relación con el Padre. Esta sanación se logró al ofrecerse a sí mismo en la cruz por toda la humanidad. Gracias a este acto de amor, un día tendremos vida eterna. Lo único que falta es nuestra voluntad, porque podemos rechazar fácilmente a Jesús como nuestro Salvador y, por lo tanto, rechazar la vida eterna. Al recordar a nuestros seres queridos que han fallecido, tenemos la esperanza de que no rechazaron el regalo de la salvación que Jesús nos ofrece. Sabemos que Jesús se ofrece por ellos y por todos nosotros con la esperanza de que tengan vida eterna. En la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo, Jesús hace una promesa audaz: dice que no rechazará a nadie que el Padre le entregue, que no perderá a nadie que le sea dado y que lo resucitará en el último día. Añade que todo aquel que vea al Hijo y crea en él tendrá vida eterna. Aquí es donde entramos nosotros: debemos creer en él, pues si no creemos, rechazaremos este regalo de la salvación.

Hermanos y hermanas, en este Domingo de los Fieles Difuntos, no solo recordemos a nuestros seres queridos con amor y oraciones, sino que también reflexionemos sobre el estado de nuestras almas. Reflexionemos sobre nuestra relación con Jesucristo. Preguntémosnos: "¿Lo acepto como mi Señor y Salvador?". Cuando lo ves, especialmente en la Eucaristía durante la comunión, ¿crees en Él? ¿Crees en Él hasta el punto de seguir todas sus enseñanzas y evitar el pecado? Creer no se trata solo de palabras, sino también de acciones. Si lo haces, la próxima vez que alguien te pregunte: "¿Quién es Jesús?", tu corazón y tu alma estarán deseosos de compartir tu amor y tu fe en Él, y al hacerlo, recibirás la recompensa de la promesa de la vida eterna y la resurrección en el último día.


