

Fourth Sunday of Advent

Matthew 1:18-24

We are now in the fourth and final week of this Advent season and quickly approaching the long-awaited day that we have been preparing for, Christmas. Christmas is a day where we meet the one that we have anxiously waited for. The One who is called the Messiah and would change the world forever. The One that would enter our hearts and transform us in a way that only He can. It is He, the one that shall be named Emmanuel because God is with us. Jesus is the long-awaited person that we have been preparing for this Advent season and we are now at the doorstep leading to that final moment where we will encounter Him on Christmas Day.

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, we are transported to that event where Joseph was in the process of marrying Mary. However, there was a little problem. Mary was with child miraculously through the Holy Spirit. Joseph, not knowing, decided to leave Mary to avoid shame being brought to her because the child was not his and would be seen as adultery, which was punishable by stoning to death. However, the angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream telling him to stay, father the child and name Him Jesus. The Gospel writer goes on to remind us of the prophetic words of Isaiah by continuing his writing saying, "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means 'God is with us'."

This wonderful example of Joseph, another great model of faith, is an example to be followed. He loved Mary so much that He chose to walk in faith and believe that in fact, the child that she was carrying was not man's, but conceived through the Holy Spirit. My brothers and sisters, walking in faith is not easy. In fact, just living in this cold and dark world is difficult enough, but the good news is that we are not alone. God Himself chose to become man in order to walk with us, to carry us and to lead us from darkness into the light. We are not alone because Emmanuel, God is with us, and He will be with us until the end of times.

Cuarto Domingo de Adviento

Mateo 1:18-24

Nos encontramos en la cuarta y última semana de este tiempo de Adviento y nos acercamos rápidamente al tan esperado día el que nos hemos estado preparando: la Navidad. La Navidad es el día en que nos encontramos con Aquel a quien hemos esperado con tanto anhelo. Aquel que es llamado el Mesías y que cambiaría el mundo para siempre. Aquel que entraría en nuestros corazones y nos transformaría de una manera que solo Él puede hacerlo. Es Él, a quien se le llamará Emmanuel, porque Dios-con-nosotros. Jesús es la persona tan esperada y por la cual nos hemos estado preparando durante este Adviento, y ahora estamos a las puertas de ese momento final en el que nos encontraremos con Él el día de Navidad.

En la lectura del Evangelio de este domingo, somos transportados a aquel acontecimiento en el que José estaba a punto de casarse con María. Sin embargo, había un pequeño problema. María estaba embarazada milagrosamente por obra del Espíritu Santo. José, sin saberlo, decidió dejar a María para evitar ponerla en evidencia, ya que el niño no era suyo y sería considerado adulterio, lo cual era castigado con lapidación. Sin embargo, un ángel del Señor se le apareció a José en un sueño, diciéndole que se quedara, que aceptara al niño como suyo y que lo llamara Jesús. El evangelista nos recuerda las palabras proféticas de Isaías, continuando su relato con las palabras: «He aquí que la virgen concebirá y dará a luz un hijo, a quien pondrán el nombre de Emmanuel, que quiere decir Dios-con-nosotros».

Este maravilloso ejemplo de José, que es un gran modelo de fe, es un ejemplo a seguir. Amaba tanto a María que decidió caminar en fe y creer que, en efecto, el niño que ella llevaba en su vientre no era de ningún hombre, sino concebido por el Espíritu Santo. Hermanos y hermanas, caminar en fe no es fácil. De hecho, vivir en este mundo frío y oscuro también es bastante difícil, pero la buena noticia es que no estamos solos. Dios mismo eligió hacerse hombre para caminar con nosotros, para sostenernos y para guiarnos de la oscuridad a la luz. No estamos solos porque Emmanuel, Dios con nosotros, y estará con nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos.


