



# REFLECTION

---

Second Sunday of Lent

Matthew 17:1-9

This Sunday we celebrate the Transfiguration of our Lord. It is in this moment that Jesus reveals His Glory to the apostles Peter, James and John. He reveals Himself as God. Jesus was there wearing dazzling white clothing, a white that they could never imagine. The apostles then saw Jesus with Moses and Elijah, two dear prophets that the Israelites esteemed and revered. What a glorious sight indeed. You would think that Peter, James and John would be lost in awe at this moment dropping to their knees in reverence and prayer, but they didn't. Matthew tells us that they were also afraid, but why?

Peter, James and John were terrified because in the Transfiguration of Jesus, they knew that Jesus was God and were in His presence. They were overwhelmed by what was happening. It must have been an amazing experience, but at the same time, maybe they feared something happening to them because they knew that they were sinful men and therefore impure. Could it be that they knew about the priests in the Old Testament where if they entered the presence of God, in the Holy of Holies, impure, they would die? Maybe they felt unclean and feared dying for being in His presence. This might seem absurd to some, but what an amazing testament of having a healthy fear of God where you believe that you are in His presence and fear that your sins have caused great offenses to God. A fear of hurting the one that created you out of love.

My brothers and sisters, let's take a moment to reflect on our relationship with God. Are you like the apostles in today's Gospel reading where they are terrified to be in the presence of God or are you indifferent? Regardless of your state in life, seek to be in His presence always. Grow your relationship with God so that you always feel comfortable in His presence, like you would with your mother and father. He is waiting for you with open arms, do not be terrified, but be filled with joy in His presence.

Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma

Mateo 17:1-9

Este domingo celebramos la Transfiguración de nuestro Señor. Es en este momento que Jesús revela Su Gloria a los apóstoles Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Él se revela como Dios. Jesús estaba allí vestido con vestiduras esplendorosamente blancas, un blanco que nunca podrían imaginar. Luego los apóstoles vieron a Jesús con Moisés y Elías, dos queridos profetas que los israelitas estimaban y reverenciaban. Qué vista tan gloriosa en verdad. Se podría pensar que Pedro, Santiago y Juan estarían perdidos en asombro en ese momento y se arrodillarían en reverencia y oración, pero no fue así. Marcos nos dice que también estaban asustados, pero ¿por qué?

Pedro, Santiago y Juan estaban asustados porque en la Transfiguración de Jesús sabían que Jesús era Dios y estaban en Su presencia. Estaban abrumados por lo que estaba sucediendo. Debió ser una experiencia asombrosa, pero al mismo tiempo, tal vez temían que les pasara algo porque sabían que eran hombres pecadores y por lo tanto impuros. ¿Será que sabían de los sacerdotes en el Antiguo Testamento donde si entraban a la presencia de Dios, en el Lugar Santísimo, impuros, morirían? Quizás se sentían impuros y temían morir por estar en Su presencia. Esto puede parecer absurdo para algunos, pero qué testimonio tan impresionante de tener un temor saludable de Dios donde crees que estás en Su presencia y temes que tus pecados hayan causado grandes ofensas a Dios. Un temor de herir a quien te creó por amor.

Mis hermanos y hermanas, tomemos un momento para reflexionar sobre nuestra relación con Dios. ¿Eres como los apóstoles en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy donde están asustados por estar en la presencia de Dios o eres indiferente? Independientemente de tu estado de vida, busca estar siempre en Su presencia. Haz crecer tu relación con Dios para que siempre te sientas cómodo en Su presencia, tal como lo harías con tu madre y tu padre. Él te espera con los brazos abiertos, no te asustes, sino llénate de gozo en su presencia.

## DID YOU KNOW?

Children and non-consensual images

Non-consensual intimate imagery (NCII) abuse can affect anyone, regardless of age or gender. In many cases, it can seem like the victim is part of the distribution of his or her own image. Even though a child may provide an intimate picture, children are not capable of understanding the implications or coping with perceived pressure to do so. No matter how an offender obtains intimate material, the victim's fear of images being shared can leave him or her feeling powerless and ashamed. NCII abuse can be used to further manipulate or blackmail a victim into more abusive scenarios. ## ¿SABÍA QUE?

Los niños y las imágenes no consentidas

El abuso por medio de imágenes íntimas no consentidas (NCII) puede afectar a cualquier persona, sin importar su edad o género. En muchos casos, puede parecer que la víctima participa en la distribución de su propia imagen. Aunque pueda proporcionar una imagen íntima, un niño no es capaz de comprender las implicaciones ni de lidiar con la presión de hacerlo. Independientemente de cómo obtenga el agresor las imágenes, el miedo de la víctima a que se compartirán las imágenes puede hacer que se sienta impotente y avergonzada. Este tipo de abuso se puede utilizar para manipular o amenazar a la víctima para que se exponen a situaciones más abusivas.
