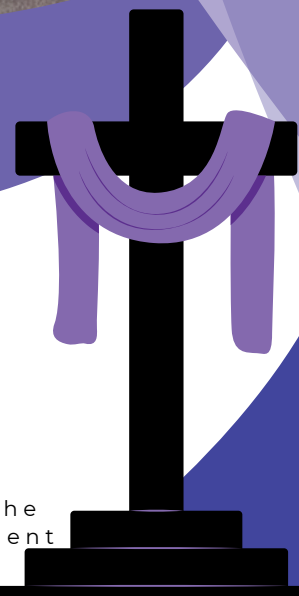

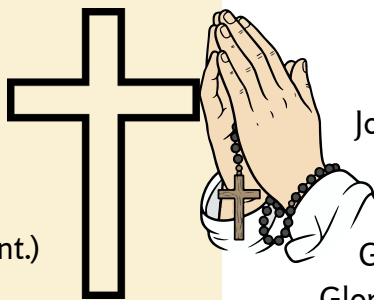

REFLECTION

The Samaritan Woman (John 4:5-42)
Third Sunday of Lent – First Scrutiny

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, we witness the encounter of the Samaritan woman with Jesus. The Samaritan woman knew that Jesus was a Jew and she was aware of their tradition where she was considered impure and therefore, a Jew could not receive anything from her, not even a cup of water. This, however, did not stop Jesus from giving her the gift of an encounter. Jesus not only asked her for water, but He offered her living water.

The woman did not understand, but the more that Jesus spoke to her, the more she wanted this water that Jesus offered. Could it be that she was tired of filling her heart with the stagnant water from the well that the world gave her and was not quenching her thirst? Could it be that deep in her heart, she knew that she needed to find a source of water that would quench her spiritual thirst, something that this world could not give her?

Could it be that she had finally found this font of living water that can only be given by the Messiah? The Samaritan woman, the one that was marginalized for being Samaritan and a woman, was chosen by Jesus to reveal himself not only as this giver of living water, but as the Messiah. In this encounter with Jesus, the Samaritan woman had the choice to either ignore and walk away from Jesus or to open up her heart to Him. In these verses of John's Gospel, we are the Samaritan woman. We wander through life searching for something or someone to quench our thirst. Our spiritual thirst. A thirst that continues to keep us in a sad or depressed state. The water that the world provides is temporary and leaves us with an empty feeling and thirsty once again. This thirst can only be quenched by the one that can give us living water and that is Jesus.

We are in the third Sunday of Lent and today we are called to have an encounter with Jesus and open up our hearts to Him. Allow Him to give you living water through His love. It is then that you will feel your thirst completely quenched and by doing so, all the issues in your life will seem small compared to His love. Just like the Samaritan woman, her life changed and she shared her love for Jesus to others. Let's do the same. There are plenty of "Samaritan women" out there that are searching for something or someone to quench their thirst and you might be the one that is chosen by God to share Jesus, the source of living water, with them.

La Mujer Samaritana (Juan 4:5-42)
Tercer Domingo de Cuaresma – Primer Escrutinio

En el Evangelio de este domingo, somos testigos del encuentro de la mujer samaritana con Jesús. La mujer samaritana sabía que Jesús era judío y estaba al tanto de su tradición en la que se la consideraba impura y, por lo tanto, un judío no podía recibir nada de ella, ni siquiera un vaso de agua. Sin embargo, esto no impidió que Jesús le diera el regalo de un encuentro. Jesús no solo le pidió agua, sino que le ofreció un manantial capaz de dar la vida eterna. La mujer no entendía, pero cuanto más le hablaba Jesús, más deseaba esta agua que Jesús le ofrecía. ¿Será que estaba cansada de llenar su corazón con el agua estancada del pozo que el mundo le ofrecía y no saciaba su sed? ¿Será que en el fondo de su corazón sabía que necesitaba encontrar una fuente de agua que podría saciar su sed espiritual, algo que este mundo no podría darle? ¿Será que finalmente había encontrado esta fuente de agua viva que sólo el Mesías puede dar?

La mujer samaritana, la que fue marginada por ser samaritana y mujer, fue escogida por Jesús para revelarse no sólo como la fuente de este manantial, sino como el Mesías. En este encuentro con Jesús, la mujer samaritana tuvo la opción de ignorar y alejarse de Jesús o de abrirle su corazón. En estos versículos del Evangelio según San Juan, todos nosotros somos la mujer samaritana. Pasamos por la vida buscando algo o alguien para saciar nuestra sed. Nuestra sed espiritual. Una sed que nos sigue manteniendo en un estado de tristeza o depresión. El agua que proporciona el mundo es temporal y nos deja con una sensación vacía y de nuevo tenemos sed. Esta sed solo la puede saciar aquel que nos puede dar agua viva y ese es Jesús.

Estamos en el tercer domingo de Cuaresma y hoy somos llamados a tener un encuentro con Jesús y abrirle nuestro corazón. Permítele que te dé agua viva a través de su amor. Es entonces cuando sentirás tu sed completamente saciada y al hacerlo, todos los asuntos de tu vida parecerán pequeños comparados con Su amor. Al igual que la mujer samaritana, su vida cambió y compartió su amor por Jesús con los demás.

Hagamos lo mismo. Hay muchas "mujeres samaritanas" que están buscando algo o alguien para saciar su sed y tú podrías ser el elegido o elegida por Dios para compartir a Jesús, quien es la fuente de agua viva, con ellos.

What to do when a child discloses abuse
 Receiving a disclosure of abuse is a huge responsibility — and one that must be handled properly to ensure the child’s safety. First and foremost, it is important to remain calm, and to let the child know that you are listening and taking them seriously. Assure them that you believe their words, and that you want to help. As soon as possible, although not while the child is talking to you, take notes and record details, and then report what was disclosed to you to the proper authorities. Qué hacer cuando un niño denuncia un caso de abuso
 Recibir una denuncia de abuso es una gran responsabilidad, y debe ser tratado de forma adecuada para garantizar la seguridad del niño. En primer lugar, es importante mantener la calma y hacerle saber al niño que lo estás escuchando y que lo estás tomando en serio. Asegúrale que crees en sus palabras y que quieres ayudarlo. Tan pronto como sea posible, aunque no mientras el niño le esté hablando, tome notas y registre los detalles, y luego informe de lo que le ha sido revelado a las autoridades apropiados.
