Camp Information

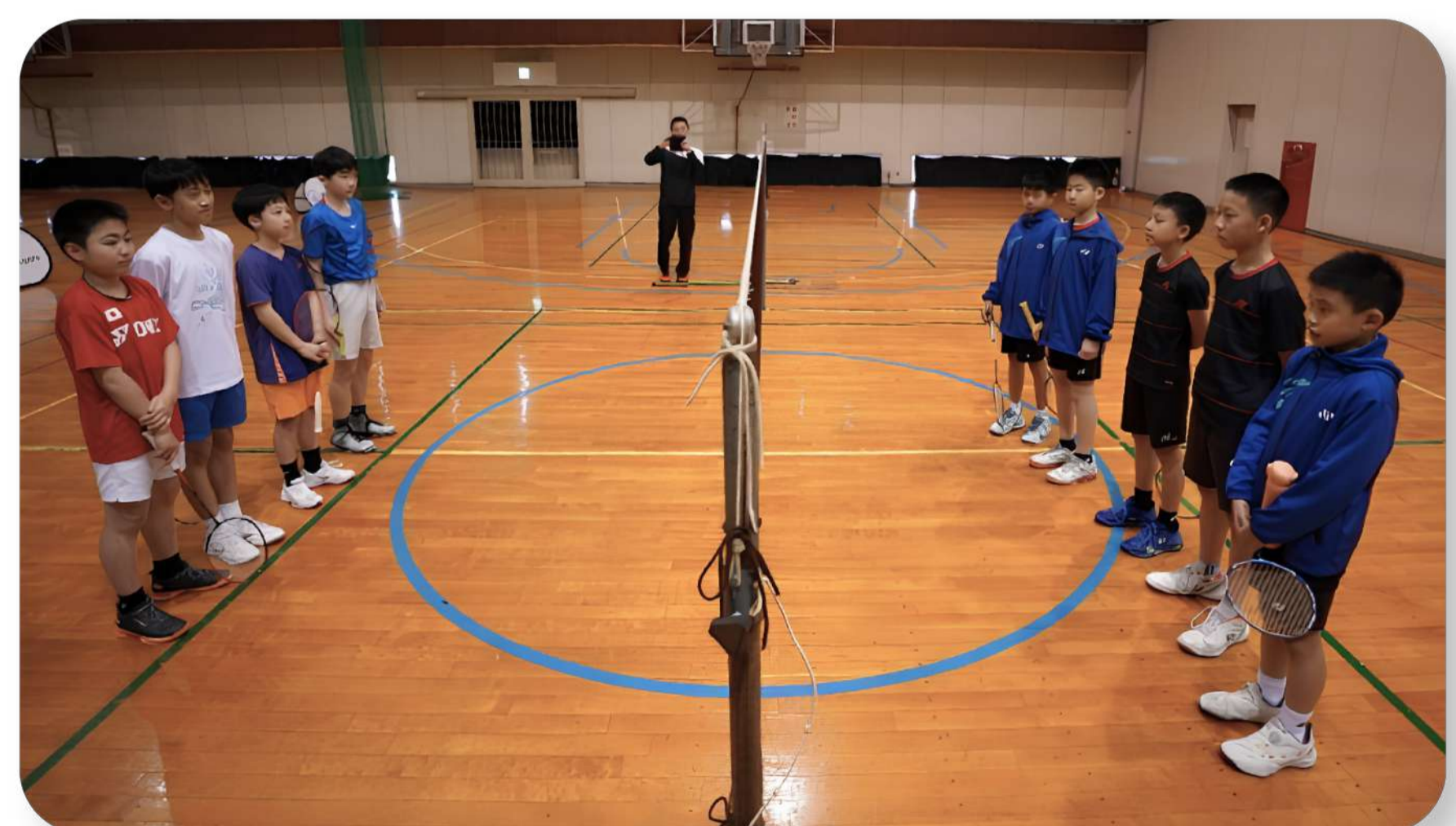
Japan Badminton Camp is open to players of all ages and levels and offers a unique opportunity to experience badminton training in Japan.

The camp takes place in Higashimatsuyama, Saitama Prefecture from **11–20 October 2026 (10 days)** or **11–24 October 2026 (14 days)**. Participation is limited to 20 juniors and 20 adults, ensuring a focused and personal training environment. Club junior groups are especially welcome, and high-intensity competitive programs for tournament preparation are available on request (please indicate this when registering).

Training is led by Akari Sato, former Japanese national team player and Super 100 champion, together with a team of experienced assistant coaches. Sessions focus on footwork, racket skills, tactics, defense, and match sparring. Players are grouped by age and level to create the best possible training experience.

Training in Japan offers a unique contrast to many badminton cultures around the world, and we truly believe every player should try it at least once. What makes badminton in Japan stand out is not only the knowledge of the sport but also the cultural values behind it. Japanese players grow up with discipline, teamwork, and respect as part of daily life, and these values are clearly reflected on and off court. As a result, players are exposed to a training environment and culture that may differ significantly from what they have experienced elsewhere.

By joining the camp, participants will not only improve their badminton but also experience Japanese sports culture, training methods, and daily life. With opportunities to train alongside local Japanese players and fellow international participants, the experience provides a unique insight into badminton in one of the world's strongest badminton nations.



Highlights

- **Open to All Ages & Levels:** No age restriction. Club junior groups can request high-intensity training programs tailored for competition preparation.
- **Japanese Training & Culture:** Train with experienced Japanese coaches and absorb the discipline and technical depth of Japanese badminton.
- **Higashimatsuyama:** Located in Saitama Prefecture, a convenient base with easy access to central Tokyo (Ikebukuro) in approximately 60–90 minutes by train.
- **Free Days & Sightseeing:** Free days are excellent for sightseeing. As mentioned above, Higashimatsuyama has direct train access to Tokyo (Ikebukuro). Another famous attraction to visit nearby is Kawagoe historic town.

Training Venue	Gymnasium in Higashimatsuyama (multiple badminton courts). Court & shuttle fees included.
Airport Transfer	Narita or Haneda International Airport. Free transfer: 12:00–20:00. Late arrivals may incur surcharge.
Accommodation	Standard: Higashimatsuyama Daiichi Hotel. Shared rooms: Garden Hotel Shiunkaku (for shared/multiple guests per room). Upgrade option: APA Hotel, Higashimatsuyama Station Front (additional charge). Transport to gymnasium included. Early booking required — limited availability.
Meals	Breakfast: At hotel / Lunch: Bento box (see photo below) / Dinner: On match/event days only Please inform of any allergies or dietary requirements in advance.

* We recommend a budget of 30 USD per day for personal expenses, such as meals, laundry, and entertainment.

* The official currency is Japanese Yen (JPY). Cards are widely accepted, but carrying some cash is recommended.

* A 10% deposit (excl. VAT) is required to secure your spot. The remaining balance is paid in cash (JPY) upon arrival.

* APA Hotel upgrade and late-arrival surcharge are charged separately. Airfare not included.



Registration

Last day to register your interest is September 15, 2026. Participation is limited to 20 juniors and 20 adults, and early registration is recommended to secure your spot. Registration is not binding until payment has been made.
