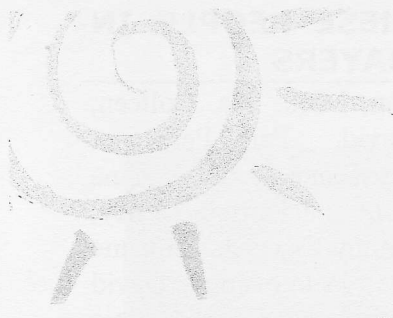

LOCATED IN RM 203 IN THE FAMILY LIFE CENTER

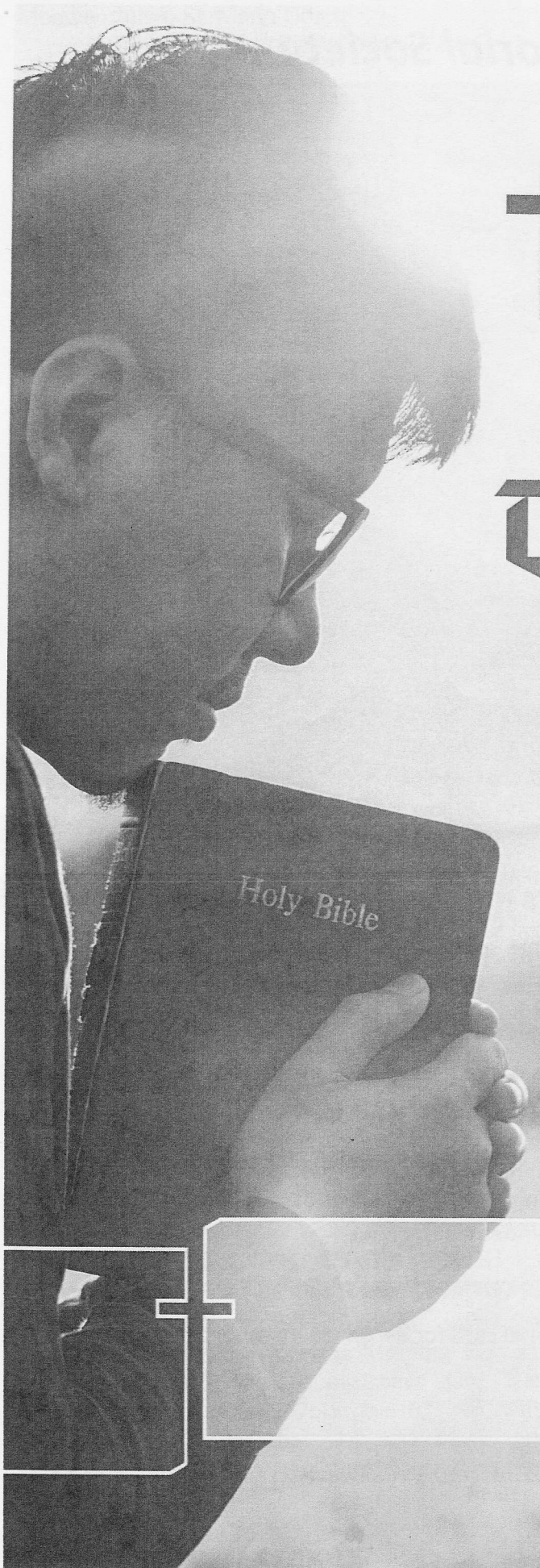

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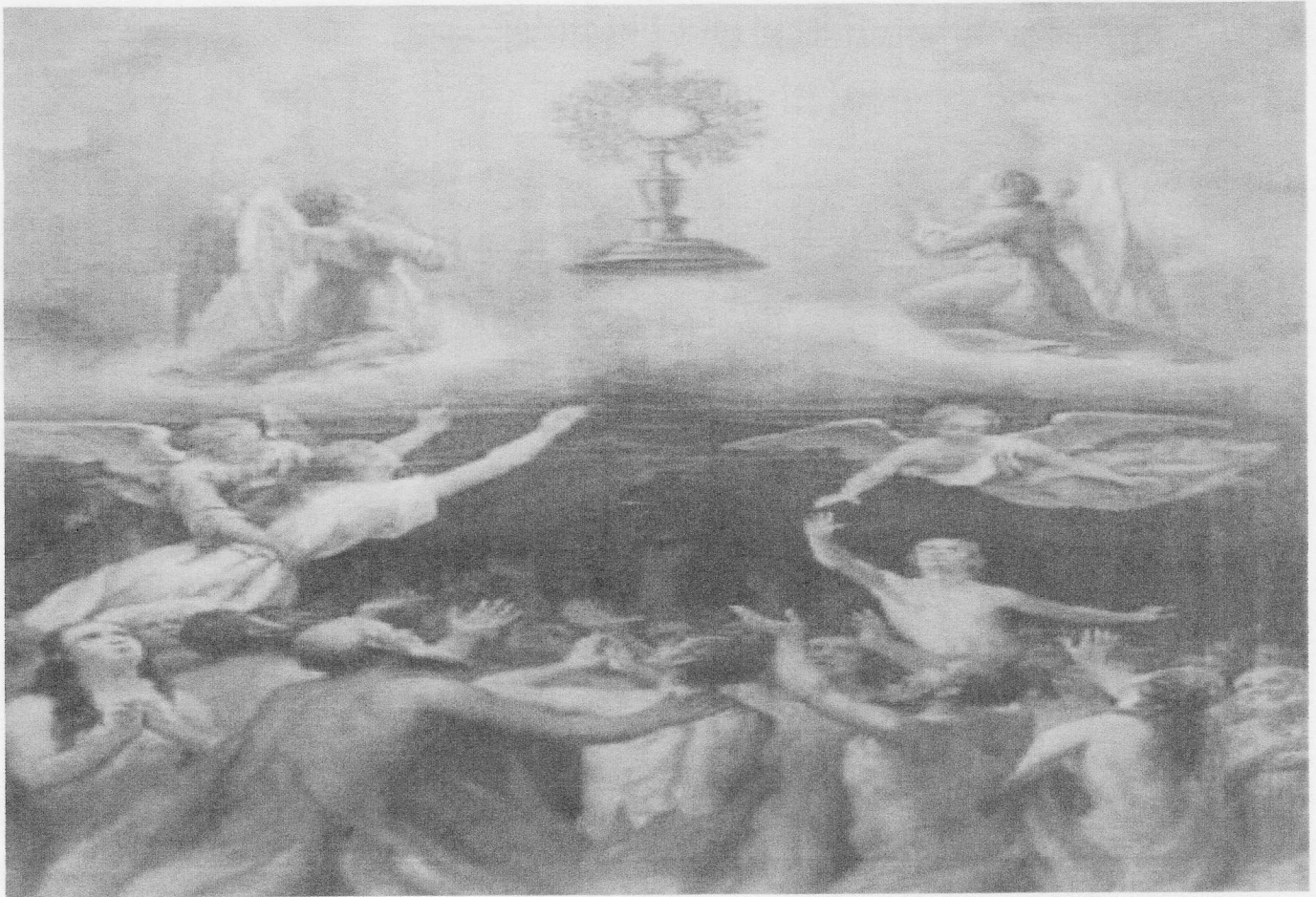


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FROM THE AUGUSTINE INSTITUTE

Never let a day pass by without saying a prayer or performing some penance for our dear souls in Purgatory.

When you are dying they will not forget you, and when you are suffering in Purgatory, they will not cease to pray for you until you are released and united with them in Heaven. Remember the most abandoned souls who have neither friend nor relative to pray for them.

Purgatorial societies are Roman Catholic Church associations or confraternities which aim to assist souls in Purgatory reach Heaven.

Information for obtaining perpetual membership for anyone living or deceased in St. Peter's Purgatorial Society is located on the south wall of the vestibule next to the information rack near the doors. With sponsorship, living members will continue to be prayed for after their death.

For either deceased or living members, spiritual bouquet cards are available for your use.

Cards are available for your use that can be used as a memorial card for deceased members, or as a spiritual bouquet card for living members.
