40 MILE PARK - RULES

General

1. All persons entering the Park shall comply with all signs and notices.

Camping

- 1. Check out time is 11:00 A. M.
- 2. Lot Leaseholders, whether present or not, are responsible for all occupants and guests.
- 3. Quiet time is from 11:00 P. M. to 7:00 A. M.
- 4. Persons under 18 years of age are restricted to their site after midnight unless supervised by a parent or guardian.
- 5. Do not place bottles, cans or garbage in fire pits.
- 6. Only bagged household garbage is to be disposed of in dumpster.
- 7. Cutting down, damaging or removal of natural vegetation is prohibited.
- 8. No alcohol shall be consumed at beach area.
- 9. All alcoholic beverages must be kept at registered camp sites or lots.
- 10. A person using the Park shall restore the area used, to a clean and tidy condition.
- 11. No person shall alter a camping permit.
- 12. No person shall transfer a camping permit to another person.
- 13. Only one (1) vehicle allowed per camping site.
- 14. Only one (1) camping unit per camping site.
- 15. Only one (1) tent per camping site.
- 16. No more than 8 persons per camping site, unless they are all members of a single family unit.
- 17. No person shall camp for more than 30 consecutive days without written permission of the Park Manager or designate.
- 18. 24 hours must elapse before a person may again camp in the campground, after the expiration of a 30-day period.

Animals

- 1. No person shall have more than two dogs in the Park.
- 2. All pets must be leashed.
- 3. No pets allowed in the swimming / beach area; public washroom; concession; or other public building.
- 4. All persons must clean up after Pets.

Fires

- 1. All fires must be confined to a firepit.
- 2. No person shall leave a fire unattended.
- 3. All fires, coals or smoldering materials must be extinguished before leaving camp or lot site.
- 4. No person shall remove a fire pit from a site.

Vehicles

- 1. All vehicles must stop at the gate and show their Park Pass or Registration before entering the Park.
- 2. No parking is allowed on roadways or grass within Park.
- 3. Boat trailers must be parked on the owner's lot or in designated parking within the Park.

Prohibitions

- 1. No person shall interfere with the rights of others to quiet and peace.
- 2. No person shall re-enter the Park within 72 hours of being lawfully removed.
- 3. No person shall remove, deface, injure or destroy any object in the Park, naturally or otherwise created.
- 4. No person shall display or post any signs or advertisements in the Park unless approved by the County or designate.
- 5. No person shall discharge a firearm within the Park.
- 6. No loitering in bathrooms.
- 7. Permission must first be obtained from Park Manager to discharge fireworks, and only then at the Beach area.
- 8. Permission must be obtained by written approval from the Park Committee for the sale of goods and services within the Park.
- 9. No person shall exceed the posted speed limits within the Park.
- 10. No person shall occupy a camp site without first being Registered.
