Petition to Protect Aotearoa Soil, Health, Waterways, and Future Generations

Tēnā koutou,

I'm reaching out to share an awareness petition opposing two proposed NZ bills (**law changes**) that would have **major** impacts on health, soil, waterways, and our food system:

- 1. The Gene Technology Bill – deregulating gene editing (including pesticide-resistant crops)**
- 2. Separately, the Government has already approved a 60× increase in allowable glyphosate residues for dry field peas. After public submissions, the proposed 100× increase for cereals such as wheat was dropped and kept at the previous limit.**
