1. WHY "I'LL JUST DO IT MYSELF" IS KILLING YOUR GROWTH

This phrase is one of the most common roadblocks to scaling — and one of the most dangerous.

It often sounds like:

- "It's faster if I just do it myself."
- "They won't do it the way I would."
- "No one else can handle this."

The problem? Every time you choose to keep a task instead of delegating it, you are saying no to higher-value CEO work — like growing revenue, refining strategy, or leading your team.
