## The AI-Readiness Checklist

Use this checklist to evaluate if your current site is a "Fossil" or an "Engine."

### Phase 1: Technical Foundations

- Site speed: Does the home page load in under 2 seconds on mobile?
- Mobile-first design: Is the experience seamless on a smartphone, or is it a shrunk-down desktop site?
- Shallow architecture: Can a user or bot reach every important page in 3 clicks or less?
- Semantic HTML: Are you using proper heading and list structure to define content hierarchy?

## **Phase 2: Content and AEO**

- The answer test: If you ask an AI assistant what problem your brand solves, does it give a correct answer?
- FAQ blocks: Do you have at least 5 to 10 clear, concise answers to common questions about your services?
- Entity clarity: Is your brand name, location, and core service stated clearly in text and not just in an image?
- Proof points: Are your case studies detailed with real-world metrics, such as "grew revenue by 20%"?

## **Phase 3: Conversion and Automation**

- Primary CTA: Is there one clear action the user should take above the fold?
- Lead capture: Are your forms integrated directly into your CRM?
- Marketing automation: Do leads receive an immediate automated follow-up after submission?
