



STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary)

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only).....£1985

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£ 1100
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises) and into the funeral directors care.	£ 170
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will usually be kept at the funeral director's premises.	£ 195
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from an oak veneer.	£ 295
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	Free of Charge
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 30 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other vehicle.	£ 225

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends do not attend the burial or cremation. It includes the care & transportation of the deceased, funeral director charges & basic coffin but does not include viewing of the deceased.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1,200
Cremation (funeral director's charges including the cremation fee)*	£1,720.50

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee#	£ 700
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is	£ 700
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot, for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee.	
In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee*	£941 - £1034
<u>In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local resident is</u>	£941 - £1034

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

The funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Limousine hire for funeral	£250
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£0.75p
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home or to a place of worship etc.) (price per transfer)	£160
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.)	Prices on request

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave or reopening and closing an existing grave.

* In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will also usually need to pay doctors fees of £82. This is the charge for a doctor to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
