Founding director and sculptor Melanie VanHouten established the non-profit, donor and visitor supported **Josephine Sculpture Park (JSP)** in 2009, on reclaimed family farmland. It is the first and largest sculpture park in the state of Kentucky.

Experience 70+ artworks along trails through our native landscapes, with new sculptures and murals installed every season.

**Visit for FREE year-round from dawn to dusk!**

**ACCESSIBILITY** Our mowed paths are 5-10 feet wide and traverse the landscape (including gentle hills) to be as accessible as possible by motorized wheelchair. Some paths are not accessible. Visitors that need mobility assistance can request to reserve our golf cart at least one week in advance by calling 502-352-7082 ext. 1.

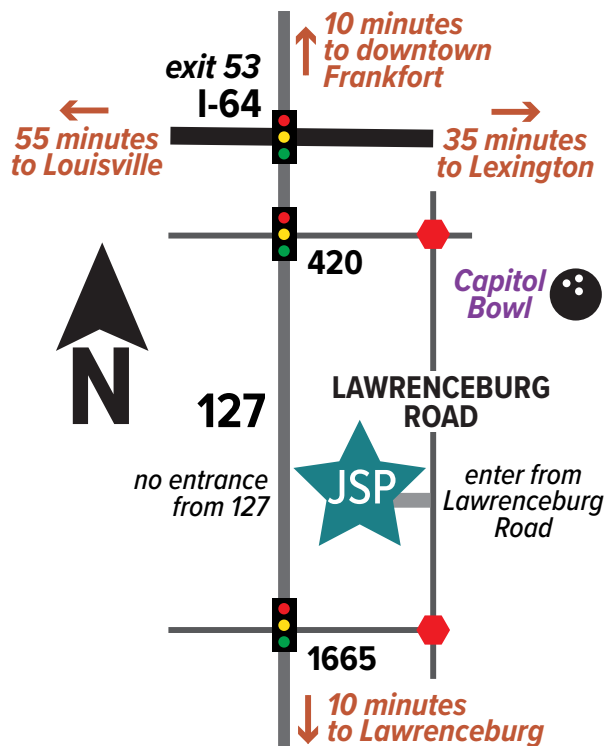

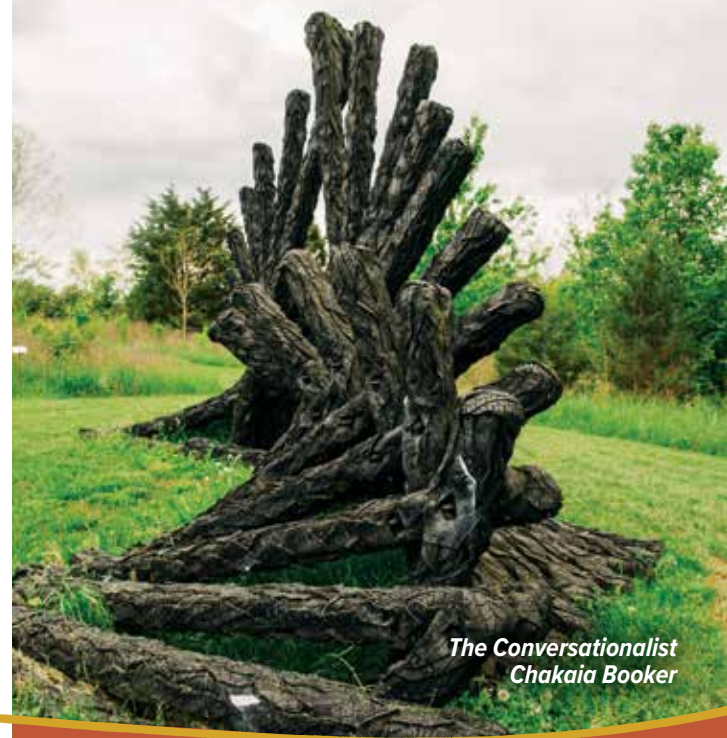
