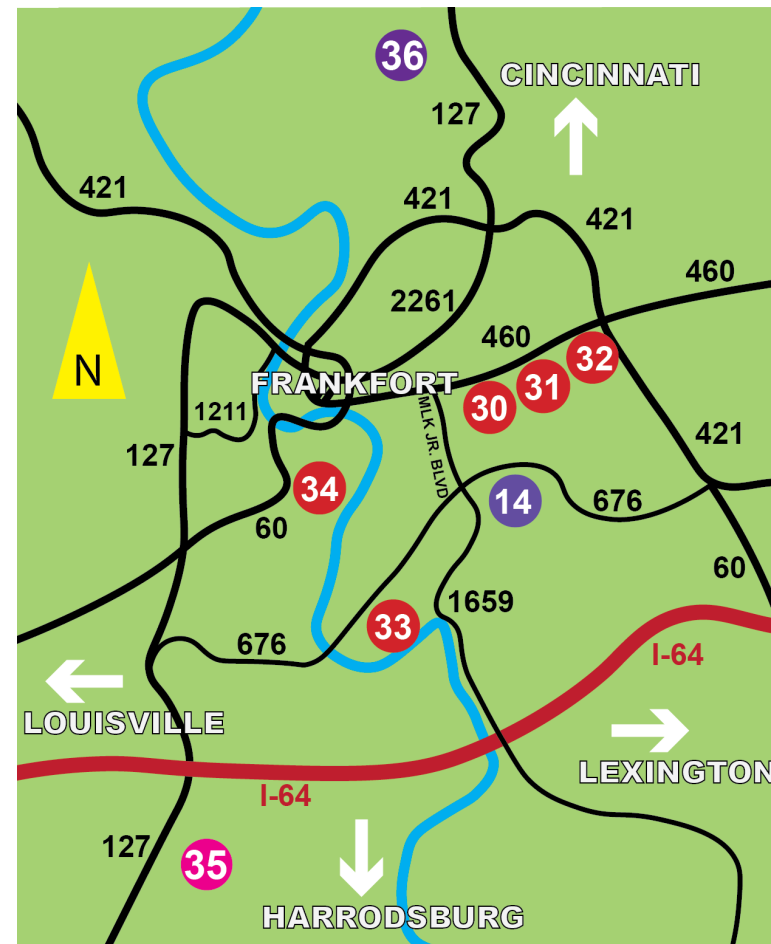

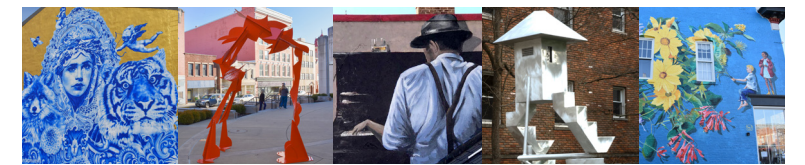


### Josephine Sculpture Park

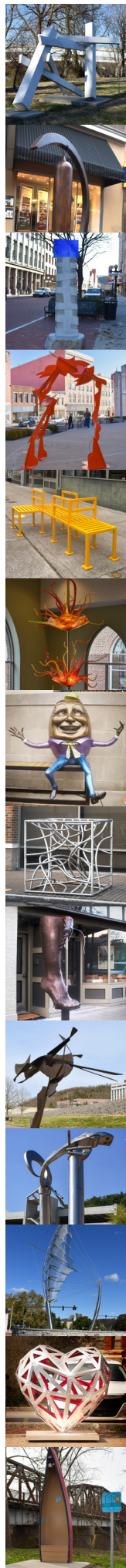
