The God Who Never Changes, 1 Samuel 15:29

Every summer I thoroughly enjoy preaching from the Old Testament! Over the past several weeks we've been in the book of 1 Samuel. This past week as I was working on the message, I came across a verse in 1 Samuel 15:29 that was an

incredible reminder to me that God never changes. It says, "He who is the Glory of Israel does not lie or change his mind; for he is not a human being, that he should change his mind."

Unfortunately, our modern-day culture runs contrary to this Biblical principle. This is called Process Theology. This is the belief the God is changeable, that he's not all-powerful, and he must respond to whatever humanity does. Culture, after all, is constantly changing, and it so very desperately wants a god that changes with it and places it's stamp of approval upon the times. But thankfully our God *is* immutable (unchanging). He cannot change for better or for worse, because He is perfect. His character will not change, and so we can always rely upon Him. We can place all of our hope, faith and trust in an unchangeable God, and that hope will never be shaken. Only He can sustain our longings, and only He can fulfill His every promise. As followers of Christ, we won't always fit into the world in which we live. In fact, we'll often find ourselves going against the flow of popular culture in most areas of life. So, it's extremely necessary and important for us to have a solid biblical foundation to stand on in the midst of our rapidly shifting cultural landscape.

We must understand how the eternal Word of God shapes our understanding of current issues and how we can share the gospel compassionately and courageously with the people around us. Here are four possible responses to our changing culture.

- 1. We can conform; We start compromising what we believe and the way we act in order to appeal to and appease the surrounding culture. We may even genuinely believe that doing so is both loving and strategic, hoping somehow people will be attracted to Jesus through a less offensive form of Christianity and will ultimately be saved. However, we have to realize that our goal isn't to make following Jesus easier. The message of the gospel is necessarily countercultural and offensive to the human heart.
- 2. We can check out; The opposite extreme is to secede from culture, distancing ourselves so completely that we never have any interaction with the world around us. Again, the intent may seem honorable and sincere because we want to remove even an appearance of evil and the temptation of sin. But Jesus specifically prayed that His Father wouldn't take His followers out of the world but protect them while they were sent into it (John 17:15-16).
- 3. We can fight against it; This approach is antagonistic and defensive. While the intent begins moving in the right direction, refusing to give in to or give up on the world around us, it misses the heart of Jesus. This response sees culture as an enemy to be defeated instead of people to be saved. Our desire must not be to prove ourselves right or to force our way on the world around us. Instead, our goal is to show Christ to be true and worthy. Just as wrong as running away from our culture is driving people away from the church. Countering culture doesn't mean attacking it.

**4.** We can counter it; Countering culture means engaging culture with conviction and compassion. We stand firmly on the truth of God, empowered by the Spirit, to extend the love of Christ to the world. Our desire isn't to conquer but to redeem. It matters what we do, how we do it, and why we do it.

The heart of every Christian should burn with an overwhelming desire for God's glory. We can't sit back and remain silent while God isn't glorified and people are on a path that ultimately leads to self-destruction. We must ask God to cause His name to be known and loved in today's culture. That desire should drive not only our personal prayers but also our public lives on a daily basis. As Christians we should never forget that a wrong response to culture is more than unhealthy or unhelpful. Engaging our culture is literally a matter of life or death.

# First Christian Church Board Meeting July 09, 2023

John Scovill called the meeting to order and opened with prayer. The minutes of the June board meeting were distributed and reviewed. John asked for additions or corrections. Bill Hobbs made a motion to approve the minutes. Skylar Starke seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The June financial reports were reviewed by Traci. We had total receipts of \$15,478.31, including \$61.31 in interest, for the month of June. We have an ending balance of \$94,866.26. The quarterly mission payments were made. A payment of \$925.00 was made for the new church directory. Traci said we received a dividend payment of \$325.00 from Edward Jones on the investment account. Matt Powe made a motion to approve the financial report, Skylar seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

John called for committee reports.

Skylar Starke & Heather Mentzer, membership/worship committee: Skylar reported that the church directory is in process. Heather asked for prayers as students and teachers are preparing to go back to school.

Donna Kaehr, Christian education: Sparks will start back up on the Wednesday after Labor Day, Sept. 6. Postcards are being prepared to pass out again this year. She is hoping to have enough participants to start Embers back up again as well. Donna will need help on Wednesdays, so anyone interested should contact her. The lessons will be covering the beatitudes in September. There will be a kickoff celebration on Sunday, Sept. 3. Plans are still being developed and may include a barbecue, inflatables, games, etc.

Helen Uitts reported that we had an average attendance in June of 33 for Sunday school and 88 for worship services.

Judy McGraw, church clerk, had no changes to report this month.

Bill Hobbs, property committee co-chair, had nothing to report.

Sherrie Riebel, mission & outreach committee, reminded everyone that the July penny dinner proceeds will go to Wings of Warriors and the August penny dinner proceeds will go to Ozark Christian College. The July penny dinner will be pulled pork.

Denise Mentzer, memorial committee, said she had been asked about the digital sign that was proposed for the use of Jerry Whitworth's memorial. It had been brought before the board about the time that COVID hit and was basically tabled. Pastor Kenyon reminded the board that bid requests had been sent out at the time, and we only received one response with a cost of \$40,000.00. He said that we need to do more research to see what else might be available, as that was too much to spend. He will call Tony Godfrey, pastor at Harvest Baptist, to see if their new sign is going to be digital and then get information on where they got it and what the pricing was like. Tom Strickler was going to see who the bank used for their sign and what the pricing ran.

#### **Unfinished business:**

Traci reported that the signers on the investment account at Edward Jones have been updated.

It had been decided at the last board meeting to pursue setting up automatic payments through Community National Bank & Trust. Traci met with Karma Wright to find out what was needed in order to set this up. The online services require separate documents to authorize persons to act on behalf of the church to create and approve files. They do not have to be signers on the checking account. The bank recommended that we have one person create the file and a second person approve the file as a method of dual control. Traci and Susan Locke asked that a third person be designated, in the event that one of them would be unavailable to create or approve a file. Judy McGraw volunteered to serve as another authorized person. Craig Mentzer made a motion to approve Judy McGraw as the third authorized person, Sherrie seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

#### New business:

Traci asked if the church wanted to consider transferring some of the funds in the checking account to a CD, now that the building is paid off and interest rates are more attractive. There was some discussion about that option and also about investing in a money market account instead for more liquidity. The question arose about the possibility of doing both. Craig made a motion to transfer \$50,000.00 to a CD at Community National Bank & Trust. Sherrie seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Pastor Kenyon suggested transferring \$2,000.00 a month into a money market account at Edward Jones. Matt made the motion to transfer \$2,000.00 monthly into a money market account, starting in August. Helen second the motion, and the motion carried. Traci was asked to find out what needed to be done to set up these new accounts.

Donna K. said that Zane will be bringing his youth group back to Joplin in June of next year. We will host them again, like we did this year. Donna will have details when it gets closer to that time.

There being no other new business, John called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Helen made the motion to adjourn, Donna K. seconded, and the motion carried. Pastor Kenyon gave the closing prayer, and the meeting was adjourned.

#### ADDENDUM TO THE JUNE MINUTES

A special board meeting was held on Sunday, June 16, after worship service in the sanctuary to vote on the details of setting up the new CD and money market accounts. John Scovill opened with prayer and turned the floor over to Traci Ridge. Traci talked to Bill Wolf at Edward Jones about the money market account and CD investment options. He suggested that the church split the CD investment into two \$25,000.00 CDs with a three-month and sixmonth term. Traci had information about the CD rates currently being offered at Edward Jones. After some discussion about the potential cost of fees for transferring funds to a CD at Edward Jones, it was decided to stick with the decision to open the CD at Community National Bank & Trust for nine months at a rate of 4.95%. Pastor Kenyon made the motion, Skylar seconded, and the motion carried.

Discussion then followed about who should be the authorized signers to transfer funds to a money market account at Edward Jones. Since the current signers on the checking account are David Donovan, Traci Ridge, John Scovill, and Susan Locke, it was decided that Dave, Traci, and Susan should be signers on the money market account since all three live and work in Iola. Matt made the motion, Skylar seconded, and the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned, and Pastor Kenyon closed with prayer.




