PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Kevin Cross Jr. most recently played internationally with the Tianjin Pioneers (2025-2026), in China...Cross Jr. averaged 9.2 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.4 assists...He began playing in China with Hunan Changsha at the end of (2025)...Averaging 24.2 points,10.4 rebounds and ...Cross Jr. started off the (2025) season with Zonkeys de Tijuana...Averaging 16.5 points, 8.8 rebounds, 0.9 assists and 26 minutes per game...For his (2024-2025) season, he played in the NBA G League with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers...Averaging 8.3 points, 5 rebounds, 0.8 assists and 15.5 minutes per game... Cross Jr. signed with the MHP Riesen Ludwigsburg BBL team in 2023-2024 ...After university, in (2024-2025) he played in the NBA Summer League with the Charlotte Hornets ...

COLLEGE CAREER

Cross Jr. played one (2019-2020) season with the University of Nebraska...averaging 7.1 points, 3.9 rebounds, 1.2 assists and 18.3 minutes... he ranked fifth among all true freshmen in the Big Ten Conference in rebounding and seventh in both scoring and 3-pointers made (32) ... he appeared in all 32 games, scoring in double figures nine times...from (2020-2024), he played for Tulane University...in the (2020-2021) season, he averaged 6.9 points and 4.7 rebounds, averaging 22.2 minutes per game...he played in all 23 games...and ranked second on the team in rebounding...he started in 28 games in his (2021-2022) season...averaging 13.9 points...shooting .520 from the field which ranked Cross Jr. first in the AAC...he ranked third in the AAC for rebounds per game at 6.7 and first in defensive rebounds at 5.85 per game... this earned him All-AAC Third Team Honor and AAC Most Improved Player of the Year...in his (2022-2023) season...he was a preseason AAC Second Team All-Conference Selection...starting in 29 games...he averaged a career high of 14.9 points per game, 6.7 rebounds and 4.2 assists... he broke Tulane's record for most points (24) and rebounds (13) in a AAC semifinals game vs. Wichita State... .. he earned AAC Third Team All-Conference Honors and NABC All-District 24 honors...in (2023-2024) he averaged 17.5 points, 7.3 rebounds and 4.6 assists to finish his university career...

Cross represented the USA at the World University Games in Chengdu, China...going on to help the team win bronze....
