PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Trevon Scott has played across the NBA, the NBA G-League, the CEBL and internationally across his career...Scott spent the (2025-2026) season with the NBA G-League Long Island Nets...Averaging 10.9 points, 4.3 rebounds and 1.7 assists...Scott appeared with the NBA Brooklyn Nets the same season...Averaging 8 points, 5.2 rebounds and 1.7 assists...And appeared in the CEBL with the Calgary Surge...Averaging 8 points, 7 rebounds and 3 assists...In (2024-2025) he played for the Winnipeg Sea Bears in the CEBL...Averaging 13 points, 7.6 rebounds and 1.5 assists...He played for the NBA G League Long Island Nets that same year...Averaging 11.6 points, 7.1 rebounds and 1.9 assists...From (2023-2024), he played for two NBA G-League Teams...With the Osceola Magic, he averaged 6.2 points, 1.0 rebounds and 0.9 assists...With the Greensboro Swarm...He averaged 6.4 points, 4.1 rebounds and 0.8 assists...Scott ended his (2022-2023) season with the Greensboro Swarm... Averaged 17.4 points, 6.9 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 34.5 minutes in 10 games...Achieved three double-doubles... Had a 53.8 field goal percentage... Scored 20+ points five times... Scored a season-high 26 points and added 10 rebounds vs. Raptors 905... He spent part of the (22-23) season playing in the CEBL with the Calgary Surge...He started in 11 out of 12 games...Averaging 11.6 points, 5.6 rebounds, 1.4 assists and 1.0 steals...Scott also played for the Fos Provence Basket in the LNB Pro A...Averaging 7.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, 0.6 assists and 20.2 minutes in 21 games...Reached double figure scoring six times...Scored a season-high 17 points on 7-for-11 shooting from the field vs. CSP Limoges...He spent his (2021-2022) with two NBA G-League teams, the San Diego Clippers (formerly known as the Agua Caliente Clippers) and the Cleveland Charge...Across both teams during this season he averaged 10.8 points, 7.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists in a total of 32.4 minutes...Scored five double-doubles...Earned 19 points and a career-high of 19 rebounds against the Windy City Bulls...He made his NBA debut with the Cleveland Cavaliers during this season...Scored 6 points off the bench in 9 minutes against the Toronto Raptors...From (2020-2021) he played for the Salt Lake City Stars in the NBA G-League...Averaging 10.1 points, 5.3 rebounds 1.9 assists and 29.2 minutes...Starting in 13 out of 15 games played...Reached double-digit scoring nine times...Ranked second on the team in minutes and third in rebounds...Scored a season-high 17 points and added six rebounds vs. Iowa Wolves...signed with the Leones de Ponce of the Puerto Rican Baloncesto Superior Nacional (BSN) on October 18, 2020. This marked his first professional basketball stop.

COLLEGE CAREER

Scott played all four years with the University of Cincinnati Bearcats from (2016-2020)...He finished his university playing the (2019-2020) season averaging 11.4 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.2 assists...Appeared in all 30 games...Ranked among league leaders in AAC games in rebounds (first at 11.6), defensive rebounds (first at 8.9) field goal percentage (third at .511) and minutes played (third at 35.6)...He was the first player since (1982-1983) to average a double-double for a season...He recorded 13 double-doubles ...Tallied a career-high 21 rebounds against UCF....Marked the first 20 point-20 rebound performance by a Bearcat since Kenyon Martin in 1998 ...Recorded a career-high 25 points and 19 rebounds while shooting 61.5 percent (8 of 13) from the floor with a trio of 3-pointers against Memphis...Scored a career-high 25 points against UConn...And led UC in rebounds in 23 games...In his (2018-2019) season, he averaged 9.3 points, 6.9 rebounds and 1.5 assists...Starting in all 35 games...Recording five double-doubles including 17 points and a career-high 12 rebounds against SMU ...Scored a team-high 20 points on 9-of-15 shooting 2 three pointers and 9 rebounds at UCF ...He achieved a career-high 22 points and matched a career-high with 10 rebounds while making 12 of 13 free throws vs. Northern Kentucky...Scott scored in double figures in 16 games ...Led the Bearcats in rebounding in 19 games ...And was named to the American Championship All-Tournament Team... In his (2017-2018) season he played in all 36 games...Averaging 3.1 points, 3.6 rebounds, and 0.9 assists...Grabbing at least one rebound in 30 of all 36 games...For the (2016-2017) season, he played in 35 games...Averaging 3.1 points and 2.5 rebounds.....Scott was awarded AAC's Defensive Player of the Year, AAC's Most Improved Player and AAC's Sportsmanship Award winner...
