### Outreach

Gaetz Outreach (GO) continues to connect our church congregation with various charitable organization by providing information about them, understanding services provided, and how GO can be of support. We follow their requests/needs and try to let you know how you can help. Check out the church website for further details or the Gaetz Memorial United Church Facebook Group. Donations can be taken directly to the organizations or brought to Gaetz church to be left in the containers at the back of the Narthex.

Our church is also very aware of the wider outreach needs regionally, provincially, federally and internationally. Through the Harold Parry Fund, GO makes regular donations throughout the year. In October, 2024, \$5000 was distributed by the Board to CAWES, Safe Harbour, McDonald House, CARE & Salvation Army Backpack & Adopt-a-Family programs. In March 2025, GO recommended the Board distribute \$5000 to HOMES, UCC Philanthropy Unit (Emergency Response), Canada Mental Health Association (Amethyst House), the Friendship Society & Youth HQ (Headquarters).

At the present time, we are desperately in <u>need of volunteers</u> to be part of this OUTREACH (GO) committee. Please contact the Board or Leila if you are interested.

The world is in desperate need in so many ways. Millions of people live in war-torn areas and in refugee camps. The needs are always there. We in Red Deer Alberta are generally so fortunate to live in safe spaces with most daily needs met. But this is still not so for many people locally and beyond. 
Tracy in the office can set this up for you, and she can also help you to arrange to leave a donation through our new Legacy Fund.
