

Pastor's Message

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time C

"....As he was entering a village, ten lepers met him. They stood at a distance from him and raised their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" And when he saw them, he said, "Go show yourselves to the priests." As they were going, they were cleansed. And one of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of lesus and thanked him.....Luke 17:11-19

What is gratitude? To whom am I grateful, what does gratitude refer? How do I show gratitude, and does this word exist in my life, do I use it? Gratitude is not just a sign of good manners, but an attitude that measures a person's greatness, their selflessness, and nobility. A grateful person is one who knows they don't owe everything to themselves but sees that they are part of a community to which they owe almost everything, that they are indebted to others, that they should be grateful for everything. And this situation makes me happy. Not everyone is obligated to be grateful, they don't have to feel grateful. Jesus doesn't expect gratitude from people. He met two days ago maybe a few hundred, or during the day 50, perhaps many of these people crossed Jesus' path, but today, Jesus asks about the nine healed. Were not ten healed, and only one Samaritan returned to thank and praise God? Gratitude requires grace. What we notice in today's Gospel: these ten lepers did something to be healed. They came to Jesus, stopped, and asked for healing. When Jesus said, "Go to the priests," they fulfilled Jesus' command. God does not expect us to be grateful for things and matters that have not touched us or that we have not received. The most interesting thing in our lives is that we fail to realize that we confine our lives to certain frameworks and cling to them, which can lead to us never being cleansed of the leprosy of our lives. The next step in the Gospel is the words of Jesus, who says: "Go to the priests and show yourselves to them." Then he complains that they didn't come to thank him for the gift of healing. Gratitude and thanksgiving could have occurred among the priests; any place for gratitude was good.

The most important thing in life is not what we received from God, but discovering through whom we received this gift. And here we see greatness in this one leper who returned, that he not only noticed the gift received from God, but also saw through whom God gave him this gift. Therefore, he returns to Jesus and is grateful. The wisdom of life is to notice through what person, through what event, God gave me grace-am I aware of what I have? Jesus seems inconsistent, because on the one hand, he tells them to go to the priests, and on the other, he regrets that they did not return to Him and thank God. From what lesus told them, we can only note the lepers' obedience to Jesus. The answer may be that these poor lepers were believing Jews, faithful to the law, and they heard the word. This commanded them to be obedient to the end. In the name of faithfulness to Jesus' word, they were unable to return to Him and thank Him, except for this one Samaritan. To listen to Jesus means to be faithful to Jesus. To obey Jesus means to be a person who uses logic, wisdom, and reason; it means doing things that are most often related to love.
