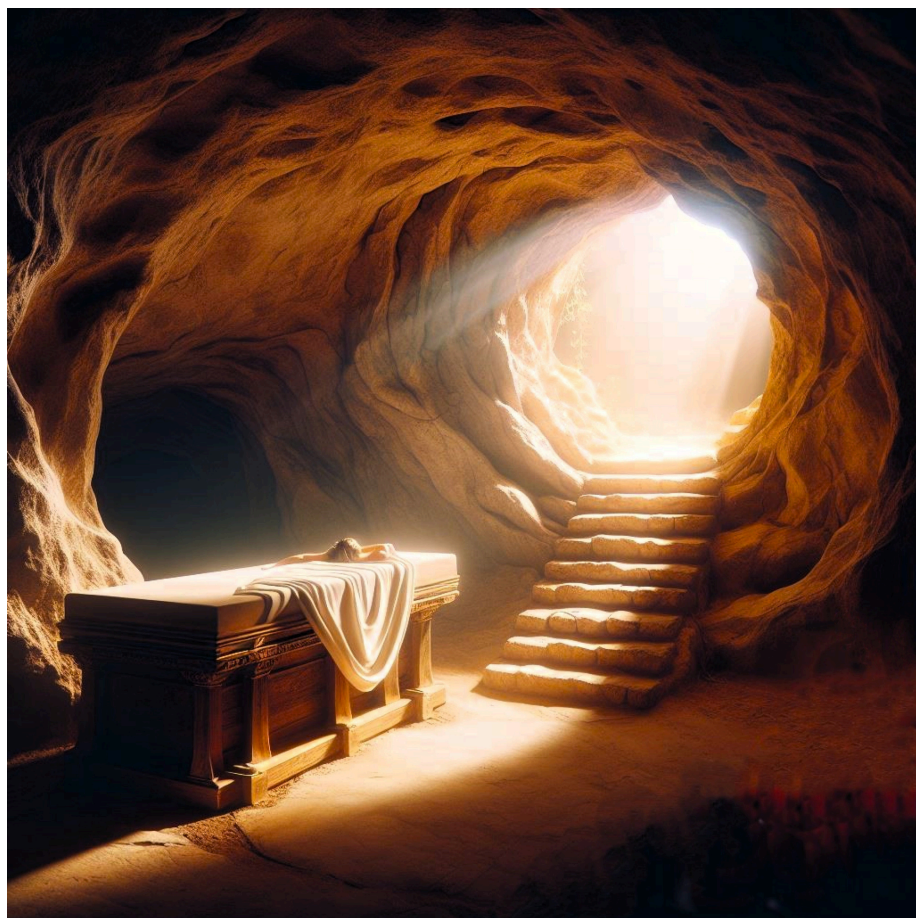

Hearing Assistance Now Available

Option #1



Around-ear speaker earphone. Hangs on outside of ear. Excellent sound quality. Can be used with all Williams AV receivers and Pocketalkers®.

Option #2



The neckloop is a miniature audio induction loop worn around a user's neck. It uses invisible magnetic energy to transfer the electrical signal from a sound source (Pocketalker, FM Receiver, etc.) directly into a hearing aid equipped with a T-coil.

When the audio signal from an earphone or headphone jack is fed into the neckloop, a magnetic field is created around the neckloop wire and user's head. As the audio signal varies, the magnetic field also varies. The varying magnetic field induces a small electrical current in the hearing aid T-coil corresponding to the original audio signal. The T-coil's signal is then amplified and converted to sound by the hearing aid.

St. Therese now has 4 sets of receivers and a choice of attachment to use. They are available in the gathering space. Please return back to the charger after use and if you need assistance, please ask an usher.

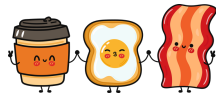
