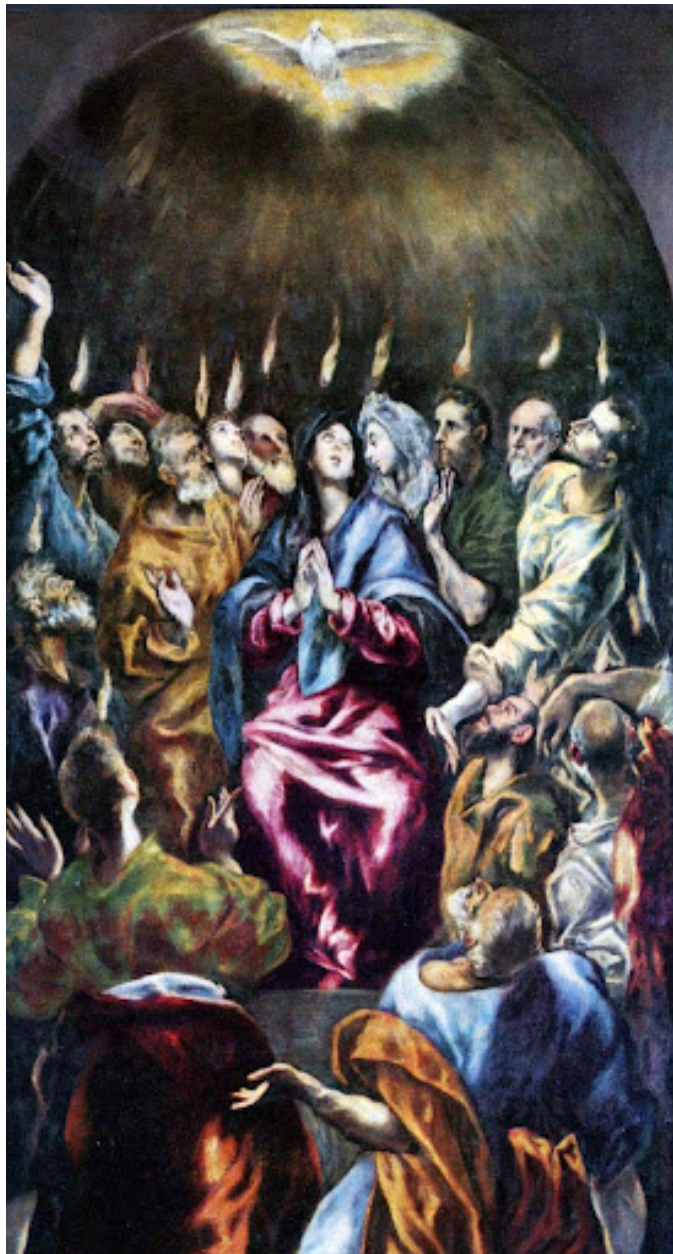

## Pentecost Sunday, Cycle A 2026

A significant amount of time has already passed—a full 10 days since the Ascension of the Lord Jesus, and 50 days since His Resurrection. A new order has arrived: the Church, and within it, the Holy Spirit—the One who is meant to teach us and guide us along God's path. This grants us participation in the fullness of God's life, which is precisely why the Holy Spirit is given. There is only one condition: we must receive the Holy Spirit. All too often, we receive and choose the spirit of this world instead. Today's Gospel speaks of how this Holy Spirit was given to the apostles on the day of the Resurrection, and later, on the day of Pentecost. Let us look closely at these two events.

The first account, coming from the day of the Resurrection, points to and echoes the divine act of creation. It was God who formed the body of man and breathed the breath of life into his nostrils. Thus, we have eternal life, an immortal soul, and a likeness to God.

The second account takes place fifty days after the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus, where something more occurred. On this day, the Holy Spirit united the individual, reborn-in-Christ apostles into a single Church. We can see a reference here to the building of the Tower of Babel—the Church, in this dimension, reaches all the way to heaven because God Himself is the builder and designer. Work on the Tower of Babel ceased because God confused the people's languages; here, in building the Church and its unity, God brings about understanding, and the language that repairs the division is love.

This outpouring of the Spirit is also an image of Mount Sinai. Fifty days after crossing the Red Sea, God gave the Ten Commandments on the mountain. Let us ask ourselves today: does the Spirit of God dwell in me? Do you remember the day when the bishop laid hands on your forehead, how you received the Holy Spirit and became mature in the faith? It is this Spirit who builds the Church here on earth, sanctifies it, and leads it to eternal life. Jesus did not wait for the apostles to become mature or for fear to completely leave their minds. At the very best moment of their lives, He gives them peace, asks them to lift up their eyes, and they receive the gift—the privilege—of the forgiveness of sins. They are sent forth, and God will be their strength.

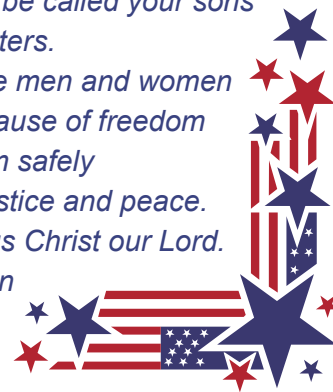
