Trinity Sunday, Cycle A 2026

"...For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through Him. He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God." (John 3:17-18).

The history of salvation is necessary—all these saving events throughout hundreds of years of time are needed—to understand these words of Jesus today. In His plan to restore humanity after original sin, God decided to offer a path of redemption. So that man could discover this path, God also decided to reveal Himself to mankind. The motivation behind this was to build a path of trust and intimacy with God, establishing a relationship with human beings. To achieve this, the help of Christ, the Son of God, was required. Through His life here on earth, He led us to the Holy Spirit, who became the beginning of the Catholic Church and remains our guide. The truth about the Holy Trinity was revealed, just as Jesus said: no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal Him.

The love of God is a daily action for the benefit of humanity, because it is filled with the language of love. This is precisely what unites the Holy Trinity—love. And this is what becomes a model for us to imitate every single day. Christian theology defines God as pure Spirit, an eternal being, omnipotent and infinitely perfect. St. Thomas Aquinas points out that the nature of God is self-subsistent being (*ipsum esse subsistens*)—God does not "have" being, but He is being itself in its purest form. Meanwhile, the attributes of God and His relationships are characterized by love and mercy, but also by absolute justice and holiness.

St. Athanasius, in his famous creed, states: "Now this is the Catholic faith: We worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity; neither confounding the Persons, nor dividing the Essence. For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Spirit. But the Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, is all one: the Glory equal, the Majesty co-eternal."

U.S. Bishops to Meet June 10-12 in Orlando; Assembly to Be Live Streamed:

From the USCCB: The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) will gather for the 2026 Spring Plenary Assembly in Orlando, Florida, June 10-12. The public sessions on June 10 and 11 will be livestreamed on the USCCB website.

Consecrating the United States to the Sacred Heart of Jesus— Livestream:

From the USCCB: In celebration of the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the U.S. bishops will consecrate the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Thursday, June 11. The special Mass of consecration, will be livestreamed on the USCCB's YouTube channel. The bishops' livestream event is intended to be a catalyst to encourage parishes and individuals to participate in the America 250 commemoration by contributing to 250 Hours of Adoration and/or 250 Works of Mercy.
