The Knights of Columbus are holding the annual Blood of Jesus Litany and Holy Rosary. The event takes place every

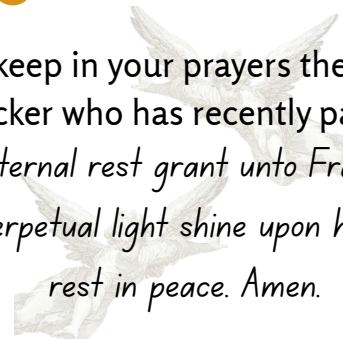
Wednesday during the month of July. (1,8,15,22,29) at 6:00pm by the Marian statue behind church.
