AUGUST FEST RAFFLE NEWS

First of all, THANK YOU to all who participated in this year's raffle event – the raffle being very important as it raises a large share of money from the event. God bless all of you for your support.

A few interesting facts:

- Of the registered parish envelope holders in our parish, only 37% participated in the Raffle.
- Of those parishioners who bought raffle tickets, 80% bought 3 or more books. (3 books sold for \$60.)
- Of those participating, 68% bought/sold their tickets before 8 August (1st day of event), whereas 32% returned/bought on the picnic grounds during the event.
- Generous souls like Dawn Eckert donated 2 regular season Packer tickets (club seats + stadium parking) and Dave/Kari Carroll donated 2 regular season Packer tickets, helping ticket sales due to their Packer ticket donations.
- There were 20 people who sold 40 or more raffle tickets this year compared to 15 people last year.
