

Liturgy & Life

When teaching a religion class, I asked the students what they thought being humble meant. One student said being humble meant that you did not think very well of yourself. In the gospel from the community of Luke, we find that Jesus tells us something else by way of a parable. He speaks of someone inviting others to a wedding feast. Those invited were to take a place not of high honor. Instead they should sit in a lower place. After all, the one who invited the guests may come to them and ask them to move so that someone else might have the place they had taken. If you take the lowest place you might be invited to move to a higher place. As you move to a higher place, you will be honored.

Humility is not humiliation or thinking poorly of ourselves. It is rather an honest evaluation of ourselves. We should be ready to share with others. We are called by God to recognize the gifts we have and to believe that others have gifts as well. Being honest regarding who we are is important in the eyes of God. It demands that we are humble.

Being invited to the Eucharistic Banquet that we call the Mass, does not make us special in any way. We are grateful for having been invited, but we are not better because we have been invited. In fact in the parable Jesus indicates that “the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind,” should be invited and we should not expect an invitation in return. We are to eat together, not thinking we are better than others.

Humility might be our ability to think that others who might think differently than we do to be treated with kindness and respect as well. We are to be hospitable to all who enter the church door, remembering that by our Baptism we have become one with Christ. From a commentator, I read a line which says this, “True humility is grounded in earthy wisdom, knowledge that all persons no matter their circumstances, and all the created world share in an unbreakable interconnection of life given by God. We are equally loved and esteemed by the Holy One who desires the flourishing of all.” Perhaps, true humility comes when we acknowledge the great love God has for all peoples.
