



Volunteer Service Hour Form



Requirement:

Thirty hours of volunteer service from seventh through tenth grade are required prior to Confirmation. Students are encouraged to spread the hours out evenly throughout the time period. This will help to foster a habit of service and prevent the difficulty of trying to accumulate large amounts of service hours just before receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation.

15 hours must be completed through parish events. The remaining 15 can be done as community events or parish events

Any unpaid activity deemed appropriate by the Director of Religious Education or Youth Minister will be accepted.* In order to get credit for completed service hours, this form must be submitted for each event. The form should also be signed by whoever is in charge of organizing or running the volunteer activity. Some examples of acceptable service are listed below:
