

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$ 0.100000	per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$ 0.097613	per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$ 0.101465	per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2026 (current tax year) tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Wilson County ESD 4 (name of taxing unit) from the same properties in both the 2025 (preceding tax year) tax year and the 2026 (current tax year) tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that Wilson County ESD 4 (name of taxing unit) may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Wilson County ESD 4 (name of taxing unit) is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2026 (current tax year) tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 15, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. (date and time)
at ESD4 Central Station at 1402 Hospital Blvd., Floresville, Texas 78114 (meeting place).

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Wilson County ESD 4 (name of taxing unit) is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Commissioners (name of governing body) of Wilson County ESD 4 (name of taxing unit) at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
