

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

December 25, 2025 ~ The Nativity of the Lord ~ Luke 2:1-14

When I was a kid in the 80s, my favorite hero was He-Man. With his bulging muscles and magic sword, he'd shout, "I have the power!" and charge off to defend Castle Grayskull. Looking back, I realized I wasn't just entertained — I was being formed. I was learning to long for a hero, someone strong enough to defeat evil and brave enough to fight for others.

In today's Gospel, the angel announces: **"For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord"** (Luke 2:11). To Jewish ears, "City of David" meant the birthplace of Israel's greatest champion — King David, the shepherd-warrior who brought down Goliath. "Christ" meant the long-awaited anointed one. "Lord" meant divine authority.

But the surprise is this: the new David isn't a muscle-bound warrior or a Caesar on a throne. He's a powerless newborn, wrapped up tight, laid in a manger. The hero has come, but disarmed. The true champion arrives not to crush his enemies, but to be crushed for them. His power is not domination, but self-giving love. This child's birth marks a revolution in our human story. The greatest power is the *surrender* of power for love. This Christmas, we're invited to make Christ — not today's Caesar, not the false heroes of our culture — the heroic center of our lives. And as we do, we begin to reflect his power. We become radiant with the same heroic love that saves the world.







**Epiphany Blessing**

All you need for an Epiphany blessing is chalk. There are a few different formulas for blessings out there, but the essence of the ritual is always the same: a priest or the head of the household calls down God's blessing on the house and everyone who comes into it, and an inscription is made above the door in chalk.

The inscription reads: the first two digits of the year + C + M + B + the last two digits of the year. The initials C, M and B represent the names of the magi — Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar — and also signify the Latin phrase Christus mansionem benedicat: "May Christ bless the house."


