

THE GENERAL INSTRUCTION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL

The proper way to receive communion

As you approach the Body of Christ, 1st action-BOW, (not a head nod), as is a sign of reverence to the Blessed Sacrament. 2nd action-place hands out to receive after saying "AMEN." Bowing and placing your hands out is **NOT done together**. It is a 2-step process,

show of reverence, then you receive. If you receive in your hand,



YOU MUST CONSUME the Body of Christ IMMIDIATELY. No one is to walk away from the Priest or Eucharistic minister with the consecrated host in their hand. The Priest or Eucharistic Minister **will come behind you to make sure the consecrated host has been consumed**. This may be uncomfortable for you or embarrassing, **but we do not want consecrated hosts left to the unknown**. (The Body of Christ has been found lying on floor in the back of the church)

There are 2 parts of communion, <u>the Body of Christ</u> and <u>the</u> <u>Blood of Christ</u>. **BOTH deserve our respect**. Lots of times we choose not to receive the Blood of Christ and that is acceptable, **but the respect is still expected to be shown** with a BOW just as we BOW to the Body of Christ. **Reminder:** Stop....BOW to the Blood of Christ....proceed to your seat. If you do choose to receive the Blood of Christ, again it is a 2-step process, just like the host. **1**st **action**-BOW, **2nd action**-place hands out to receive the cup from the minister after saying "AMEN."

The faithful are to receive communion from the minister, they are not to take the host OR the cup for themselves. Receiving The Blessed Sacrament is an action of communion, not only with the Lord, but with the person.

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The action is one of reception and not taking.
