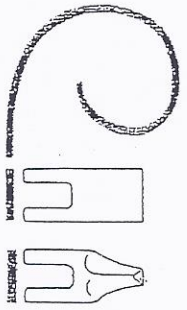
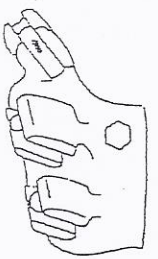


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

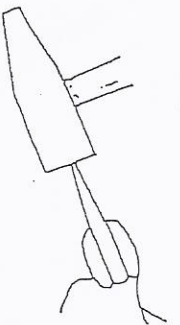


1 Cut Ribd Rubr-Lok® as long as the tooth is wide at the tangs.



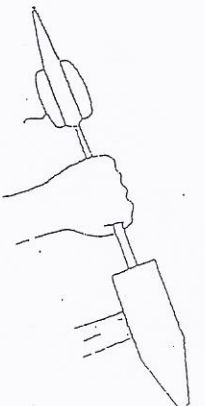
2. Insert evenly in holder.

Note: water may be used as a lubricant to install Ribd Rubr-Lok® but NEVER use grease or oil.



3. Drive tooth fully in until sealed in holder, using Pengo's SH-85 soft steel hammer. Compression of Ribd Rubr-Lok® holds tooth firmly in pocket.

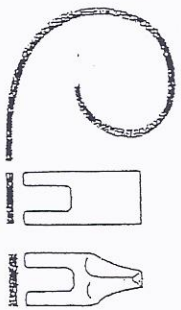
For tungsten carbide teeth: cushion carbides with softwood board before driving fully in.



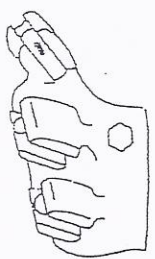
4. Remove worn teeth with drift punch. Replace Ribd Rubr-Lok® only if damage.
