Installation Instructions



To avoid person injury, shut off vehicle and relieve all hydraulic pressure. Block loader bucket using fixed mechanical stops. Wear eye protection and wear appropriate apparel.


Set parking brake and block wheels. Follow all loader or vehicle manufacturer's warnings and recommendations.



High-Pressure Fluid Hazard

To prevent serious injury or death:

- Relieve pressure on system before repairing or adjusting or disconnecting.
- Wear proper hand and eye protection when searching for leaks. Use wood or cardboard instead of hands.
- Keep all components in good repair.



MOUNTING

- 1) Insert opening of item "E" over edge of bucket until bucket edge stops against back edge of item "e" at Point "C".
- 2) Tighten lock bolts "A". Lock Bolts "A" with lock nuts "B".
- 3) Tighten retaining bolt on underside of item "E" and lock in place with lock nut (not shown).
- 4) All quick attach brackets have a hold in the center of bracket for a more secure mount to buckets that don't accommodate the quick attach mounting "F".
- 5) Route hydraulic hoses in such a manner as to avoid pinch points or hose strain.
- 6) Attach hoses to loader attachment hydraulic circuit using appropriate hydraulic couplers (not provided). Read loader or vehicle manufacturer's manuals for additional information.

Alternate Mounting

Note: Some operators may wish to use the optional mounting item "D" to attach the auger. Drill appropriate holes in loader bucket and attach using ¾ inch, grade 5 or better bolts.
