No matter the circumstances around the death, death is never easy. Usually the survivors have so many things to cope with that our help and our presence removes what can be a large burden to organize and oversee such an important ceremony. On average from the start of the funeral process to the end, 90 hours are put into the process. When a family considers the importance of the Memorial ceremony, we help ensure that you, your family, and friends stay focused on each others needs rather than the many details associated with the ceremony.

WHY HAVE A VIEWING BEFORE BURIAL OR CREMATION?

THE VIEWING

Whether or not to have the body present and available for viewing, is often the most difficult question that families have to answer. The problem becomes even more complicated because for some seeing a deceased body is helpful to give closure, but for others it can be very upsetting.

To make matters more complicated, the deceased may have requests not to have a viewing for personal reasons. Research shows that having a viewing can be vitally important for many people. In fact 90% of people will have some difficulty in the grieving resulting in hostility if the body isn't present.

Research into the grieving process supports the importance of seeing the body will help mourners accept that the death has really occurred. When death becomes real, we are forced to grieve; we can no longer deny what has happened. This may be especially important for those who had not seen the person for a while.

ABOUT A VIEWING

A *Viewing* means, that the casket, or a portion of the casket lid is left open, allowing mourners the opportunity to have one last look at their loved one. The viewing can happen during the service or in private.

Whatever you decide, it is unlikely you will please everyone. A common solution to this dilemma is a private viewing, where those who need to see the body have the opportunity to say goodbye. If some people don't want to attend, they don't have to. It's a personal choice.

An important question to ask is "What potential damage am I doing by not giving people the opportunity to say goodbye?" vs. "What are the negative outcomes by having the body present?" .

Why are your prices less expensive than other funeral providers?

We at Wendt Funeral Home want to provide everlasting tributes without the financial debt. We have a small compassionate staff that will guide you through the funeral and grieving process. We keep our overhead costs low, so that we can offer affordable services to families without causing a financial burden.

When is embalming required?

Embalming is not required by law, but can be required in certain instances. Embalming is only required when a public viewing is to take place either before burial or cremation. If there is no desire for a public viewing, embalming is not required, except in certain cases.

WHAT IF WE DON'T HAVE A MINISTER OR SOMEONE TO OFFICIATE THE SERVICE?

We work with several local Ministers and celebrants who are able to officiate a funeral service at our chapels. If you don't have someone, we would be more than happy to assist with contacting a local minister or celebrant. PAYMENT POLICY

Arrangements for payment of the total charges must be made prior to the services being scheduled. We do not contract with estates, only individuals. Payment arrangements include:

- Assignment of life insurance: Accepted, but provided that we are able to verify that the insurance policy is in force. All beneficiaries must sign the assignment forms. A 4.9% processing fee will be paid by the insurance company to Express Funeral Funding from the policy proceeds.
- Cash or personal checks
- Credit/Debit Cards: Credit card payments are subject to a 3.5% processing fee.
- Prepaid Funeral Agreement made with our funeral home or any other funeral home; Accepted according to the terms of the agreement. We will arrange for the transfer of funds, and will honor all prior arrangements made with the other funeral home.
- Financing available through third-party lenders, Family Shield Credit, or Funeral Pay Plan

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES **\$2875**

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for Direct Cremation, Immediate Burial, and Forwarding or Receiving of Remains. It includes, but is not limited to, personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to the initial call from the place of death. Arrangement conference with family and responsible parties, coordinating service plans with clergy, cemetery, crematory, and or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased. Also included in this fee are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as, but not limited to, professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, maintenance of our building, parking lot, equipment, etc. This fee for our basic services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.

EMBALMING **\$950**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If embalming is not desired, you have the right to choose an arrangement, that does not require it, such as direct cremation or direct burial.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL \$1995

(does not include casket)

The charge for immediate burial includes removal of remains, two days of refrigeration, local transportation to the cemetery, the necessary authorizations and basic service of staff. Burial time will be at the convenience of funeral home staff and cemetery and may be adjusted to accommodate staff without prior notification of the family.

DIRECT CREMATION \$1895

The charge for direct cremation includes removal of remains, necessary authorizations and basic service of the staff. This charge does not include the basic cremation container or use of facilities and staff for any visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use a required alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard, or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of fiberboard or this container can be supplied by the family.

* This package does not include the crematory fee, cremation permit, or cremation container.
