SPECIAL SECOND COLLECTION FOR HUMANITARIAN RELIEF AND PASTORAL SUPPORT IN GAZA

Pope Leo XIV has expressed deep concern for the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza, calling on the global Catholic community to respond with mercy and solidarity. Parishes in the Diocese of Scranton are holding a special collection to support Catholic Relief Services (CRS) and the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA), which are providing vital emergency aid, medical care, and relief to those suffering in the region. **Our parish will take up this special collection on the weekend of September 13 & 14.**

Despite staggering challenges, Catholic Relief Services and its partners have reached 1.7 million people in Gaza since 2023 with food, shelter, water, sanitation, and hygiene support. Checks should be made payable to St. Nicholas-St. Mary Parish. Thank you for your support.

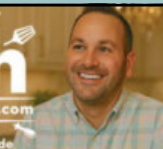
