PARISH FINANCIAL NEWS:

A parishioner recently inquired about the amount of money we send to the Diocese each year. In order to fund the operation of our Catholic schools and the various Diocesan offices, each parish is assessed (taxed) based upon its financial strength (collections, fund raisers, etc.) This past year our parish was assessed \$192,684 for the schools, \$105,288 for Cathedralism (diocese), and \$100,340 for Self-Insurance of our physical structures (including the St Mary's properties).

A WINTER COAT COLLECTION Will

take place on the weekends of **December 7th and 14th**. Boxes for your donations are located in the elevator lobby and in the back of the Church. We are accepting **"new and gently used"** clean coats, gloves, and hats of all sizes for men, women, and children.
