DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY Each year, on the



Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy. On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of Saint Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. This Sunday focuses on the gift of mercy and love given through Christ's death, burial, and resurrection. Based on the revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska, it offers a special plenary indulgence—the total forgiveness of sins and punishment—to those who go to Confession and receive Holy Communion. As Pope John Paul II stated, "Divine Mercy reaches human beings through the heart of Christ crucified." **Please note: The Youth Group and Adult Choir will be hosting a Divine Mercy Prayer Service on Sunday, April 12th, at 3:00 PM in the Church. All youth in grades 6-12 are welcome to come and participate. Students in the Confirmation class can earn service hours. Our entire parish family is encouraged to come and pray with us! All are Welcome!**

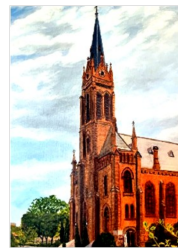

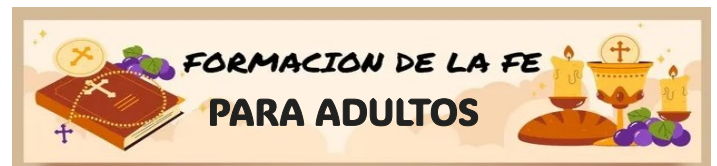
